1	User Story #1: As a developer, I want to develop the web browser for logging in and logging out.
2	User Story #2: As a developer, I want to code the database for storing user made books.
3	User Story # 4: As a developer, I want to fully integrate the databases with the website.

The following ones were rejected and moved back to the product backlog to be assigned to a future sprint at a future Spring Planning meeting.

User Story # 3

- As a developer, I want to develop the main home page for the website.
- Task:
 - Create a web browser for when a user enters into the website's domain.
 - Ensure the ability to log in and log out websites also function properly.
- Reason: Lots of issues processing the actual main homepage. Almost completed but moved back to ensure full completion.

User Story # 5

- As a developer, I want to develop the ability to upload books into the website.
- Task:
 - Create a button within the website that allows the user to click and upload a book.
 - The button allows the user to add the book to the database where it is saved.
- Reason: The ability was nearly complete, however with a few bugs it did not seem adequate enough, so we had to push it back.
