The following stories were refined and prioritized by the product owner for potential inclusion in the upcoming sprint:

- **User Story 1:** Call to Action Button – 10 pts
- **User Story 2:** Footer Section – 15 pts

Clarifications Discussed:

- **User Story 1:**
 - Clarified the purpose of the call-to-action button on the landing page
 - Defined expected user actions such as signing up or navigating to more information about the Intelligent Home Monitoring System
 - Reviewed button placement to ensure strong visibility on the landing page
 - Discussed styling consistency with the existing UI and system theme
 - Confirmed responsiveness and accessibility requirements for desktop and mobile views
- **User Story 2:**
 - Defined the structure of the footer including navigation links and contact information
 - Clarified expected links such as About, System Features, and Project Information
 - Reviewed layout structure to ensure clear organization and readability
 - Discussed consistency with the overall UI design and landing page layout
 - Confirmed responsiveness requirements for desktop and mobile displays
