1. I want the pipeline to support multiple database types so I can verify backups across heterogeneous systems.
2. I want cryptographic integrity proofs so I can be confident that backups are bit-for-bit consistent.
3. I want performance metrics so I can trend backup/restore performance and spot regressions.
4. I want corruption profiles so I can validate that our detection logic works against realistic failure modes.
5. I want detailed delta reports so I can quickly see which tables diverged and why.
