Monisha Kummari:

- How many hours did I work since the last meeting?
 - 3 hours
- What was done since the last scrum meeting?
 - Reviewed the full system flow and began identifying areas where inconsistencies may appear between model outputs and documentation.
- What is planned to be done until the next scrum meeting?
 - Start logging bugs and inconsistencies discovered during initial testing and prioritize them for fixing.
- What are the hurdles?
 - Ensuring all edge cases are captured early before deeper testing begins.

 - Set up initial end-to-end testing scenarios to validate communication between frontend, backend, and model.

 - Expand test cases and begin identifying performance bottlenecks in API response times.

 - Detecting performance issues that only appear under specific testing conditions.

Maria Vega Gonzalez:

 - Started validating preprocessing outputs against different input scenarios to ensure consistency.

 - Continue validation and check how preprocessing impacts final model predictions.
