After discussion, the velocity of the team was estimated to be 1 story per person for sprint. The product owner chose the following user stories to be done during the next sprint. They are ordered based on their priority.

User Stories:

1. As a project lead, I want realistic test actors and simulated CloudTrail activity so that anomaly detection can be validated using real AWS logs. (6 points)
2. As a SOC analyst, I want rule-based anomaly detection logic so that suspicious identity behaviors can be flagged as incidents. (6 points)
3. As a data engineer, I want recent CloudTrail events extracted and formatted so that detection logic and UI can consume consistent sample data. (5 points)
4. As a security engineer, I want structured AI explanations for detected incidents so that alerts are easier to understand and prioritize. (6 points)
5. As a project stakeholder, I want the UI updated to reflect real event and incident data so that system behavior is visually interpretable. (5 points)
