2. As a SOC analyst, I want the chat assistant responses refined and validated so that explanations of incidents are accurate, clear, and useful for decision-making. (6 points)
3. As a QA tester, I want full system testing with multiple scenarios (normal and anomalous behavior) so that all components function correctly under different conditions. (6 points)
4. As a developer, I want performance optimizations applied to API calls and data processing so that the dashboard and chat assistant respond quickly during the demo. (5 points)
5. As a project lead, I want a finalized demo script and walkthrough prepared so the team can clearly present the system workflow and key features. (6 points)
