User Stories:

1. As a project lead, I want anomaly detection logic defined and simulated historical data so that we can validate detection accuracy before deployment. (6 points)
2. As a security engineer, I want CloudTrail logs parsed and normalized into a consistent schema so that they can be reliably analyzed across services. (6 points)
3. As a SOC analyst, I want identity behavior features extracted from CloudTrail logs so that anomalies can be detected. (5 points)
4. As a project stakeholder, I want a dashboard that displays identity behavior trends and anomaly alerts so that security events are easy to interpret. (6 points)
5. As a SOC analyst, I want anomaly feature outputs validated and scaled so that the detection model can fairly compare behaviors across different IAM users and roles. (5 points)
