After discussion, the velocity of the team was estimated to be 1 story per person for sprint. The product owner chose the following user stories to be done during the next sprint. They are ordered based on their priority.

User Stories:

1. As a project lead, I want realistic test actors and simulated CloudTrail activity so we can validate anomaly detection with something close to real AWS behavior. (5 points)
2. As a SOC analyst, I want rule-based anomaly detection logic so suspicious IAM activity can be flagged as incidents. (6 points)
3. As a data engineer, I want recent CloudTrail events extracted and cleaned up so both detection and UI can use consistent sample data. (6 points)
4. As an AI engineer, I want structured explanations for each detected incident so alerts are easier for users to understand and act on. (5 points)
5. As a stakeholder, I want the UI updated to show real event and incident data, so the system's behavior is easy to interpret visually. (6 points)
