The following user stories were rejected, can be used for later development

Status: Rejected due to current technical constraints and scope limitations.

- User Story #4: As a student, I want the application to support offline translations, so that I can use it without an internet connection.

Status: Rejected due to infrastructure and performance concerns.

- User Story #5: As a student developer, I want detailed analytics on translation accuracy and usage patterns, so that improvements can be data-driven.

Status: Rejected due to prioritization of core functionality.
