Objective:

To review all progress made during Sprint 5, evaluate the final functionality and integration of the CyberSense simulator modules within the Wix platform, and confirm the team's readiness for the Capstone showcase presentation.

Sprint 5 focused on final site integration, visual refinements, accessibility updates, and the preparation of presentation materials. All three training simulators "*Spot the Phish*", *PassMaster*, and *Threat Hunter*" were successfully embedded into the Wix web app, fully functional, and linked through the main navigation dashboard.

Summary:

All user stories were completed and approved by the Product Owner. The team successfully met the sprint goal of finalizing the CyberSense simulator for deployment and presentation. The system is fully functional and visually cohesive across all modules.

Team Feedback:

What Went Well:

- Smooth collaboration between design and functionality tasks.
- Improved consistency across all modules and pages.
- All accessibility and responsiveness issues were resolved.
- Presentation materials reflect the project's goals clearly.

What Could Be Improved:

- Begin presentation design earlier in future sprints to allow for additional feedback.
- Conduct more group testing before final integration for smoother final adjustments.

Challenges Encountered:

- Slight formatting and alignment delays within Wix when republishing updated modules.
- Minor caching delays affecting page transitions during testing.

Lessons Learned:

- Establishing a design system early reduces inconsistencies later.
- Continuous integration testing helps maintain functionality after updates.
- Allocating a specific member to presentation design streamlines preparation.

Proposed Adjustments:

- Prepare for showcase rehearsal and technical demo testing.
- Verify backup of all project files and documentation in Google Drive.
- Ensure final presentation assets are optimized for both clarity and visual appeal.

Action Items for Sprint 6:

- Conduct final showcase rehearsal and walkthrough.
- Finalize and submit documentation packages (User Manual, Code Directory, Reports).
- Review and polish visual presentation for Capstone event.
- Validate all simulator features for consistency pre-showcase.
