Barbara Andino:

- How many hours have I worked since the last meeting?
 - 3 hours
- What was done since the last scrum meeting?
 - I finalized a short list of organizations that could be realistic targets for our USB drop simulation. The list includes a hospital, a university, and a corporate office. I also began taking notes on the types of assets each organization might be at risk.
