The following user stories were discussed.

- User story 17: We discussed the progress of the USB attack scenario diagram and reviewed how well it visualizes the attack flow from the initial drop to the impact stage. My team agreed that the diagram effectively represents both the attack path and the points where security controls mitigate risks.
- User Story 18: We discussed the details of the USB harmless payload. We went over how it was created, the testing environment, and how it works. We also did a test run so the team can see it in action and give feedback if need be.
