- **User Story 3:** Finalize feature development tasks and assist in testing to ensure full functionality within the final build.

Alexander Hued

- **User Story 1:** Oversee the completion and final validation of all wireframes and design components to ensure readiness for release.
- **User Story 2:** Lead the final review and refinement of the teaching methods integrated into the app's completed version.
