

1. Introduction

HouseHub is a web-based household management platform designed to help families and helpers coordinate chores, track progress, manage payments, and communicate efficiently. This User Manual explains how to use the HouseHub system from a non-technical user's perspective.

2. User Roles

HouseHub supports multiple user roles, each with different permissions.

2.1 Parent

- Create and manage chores
- Assign chores to helpers
- Approve completed chores
- Manage payments
- Communicate with helpers

2.2 Helper

- View available chores
- Apply for or accept chores
- Complete assigned chores
- Communicate with parents
- Receive payments

3.1 Accessing the Application

1. Open a web browser

3.2 Logging In

1. Enter your username and password
2. Click Login
3. Upon successful login, the user is redirected to their home page

5. Managing Chores

5.1 Viewing Chores

- Parents can view all household chores
- Helpers can view available and assigned chores

5.2 Creating a Chore (Parent Only)

1. Navigate to Dashboard
2. Click Create Chore

3. Enter chore details:

- Title
- Description
- Reward
- Due date

4. Click Submit

5.3 Claiming or Applying for a Chore (Helper)

1. Navigate to ChoresHub
2. Select a chore
3. Click Apply or Claim

5.4 Completing a Chore (Helper)

1. Open assigned chore
2. Mark checklist items as completed
3. Submit chore for approval

5.5 Approving a Chore (Parent)

1. Open completed chore
2. Review submission
3. Click Approve or Reject

6. Payments

HouseHub includes a built-in payment tracking system.

Payment Workflow:

- Payments are triggered after chore approval
- Helpers can view earned balances
- Parents can view payment history

7. Messaging & Notifications

7.1 Messaging

Users can communicate through the built-in messaging system.

1. Navigate to Messages
2. Select a user
3. Type and send messages in real time

7.2 Notifications

Users receive notifications for:

- Chore assignments
- Chore approvals
- Messages
- Payments

8. Logging Out

1. Click the user profile icon
2. Select Logout
3. User is returned to the login page
