After a show and tell presentation, the implementation of the following user stories were accepted by the product owners:

User Story 10: As a student, I want to provide quick feedback or report bugs directly from the app so that I can help improve the experience.

User Story 7: As a student, I want to switch between light and dark mode so that I can study comfortably in different lighting environments.

User Story 6: As a student, I want to see clear and helpful error messages (like “Deck failed to upload — check file format”) so that I can understand what went wrong and fix it easily.

The following ones were rejected and moved back to the product backlog to be assigned to a future sprint at a future Spring Planning meeting:

User Story 9: As a student, I want the app to adapt to my learning pace — showing me the cards I struggle with more often — so I can master content faster.

User Story 8: As a student, I want my progress and decks to sync automatically across devices so I can continue studying wherever I left off.
