What are the hurdles?

Exploring how the graphs can be used to find relationships between key terms

Kendrick Crespo:**How many hours did I work since the last meeting?**

What was done since the last scrum meeting?

Connected a simple frontend component (like a login form or data display table) to a backend endpoint to validate connectivity.

What is planned to be done until the next scrum meeting?

Research ways to prevent that the backend may send data in a way that the frontend doesn't expect it.

What are the hurdles?

The structure and format of the data returned by the backend matches what the frontend expects

Jonathan Hernandez:**How many hours did I work since the last meeting?**

What was done since the last scrum meeting?

Made continued progress on the knowledge graph component. Enhanced node and edge styling for better readability and began refining the UI layout. Also implemented basic error handling to catch rendering issues and improve stability.

What is planned to be done until the next scrum meeting?

Add interactive features like zoom, pan, and expandable nodes. Begin integrating tooltips for node details and prepare the setup to handle real data input for testing.

What are the hurdles?

Maintaining responsiveness as the graph grows in complexity and resolving occasional visual glitches when rerendering the graph.
