Work on the validation step and prepare a small batch of test documents with intended formatting issues to see if the system can catch and clean them.

Edge cases like scanned documents with large tables still need special handling strategies.

Worked on using NetworkX to implement the creation of concept graphs used for the tasks of a note summarizer

What is planned to be done until the next scrum meeting?

Compare the different graph visualization tools to determine which one is more suitable to create concept graphs

What are the hurdles?

Implementing the functionality of allowing the graph tools to have context on which key terms might be important in a document

Limited access to certain environments, slowing down testing and validation efforts

What is planned to be done until the next scrum meeting?

Inconsistent error messages or unexpected edge cases

What are the hurdles?

Ongoing limited access to critical testing environments.

What was done since the last scrum meeting?

Polished the tooltip system—now supports dynamic content updates and better alignment near graph edges. Also began initial tests with sample data tied to extracted concepts to evaluate node organization.

What is planned to be done until the next scrum meeting?

Continue integrating test data from summarization output and begin adjusting layout logic to better handle varying graph sizes and topic clusters.

What are the hurdles?

Ensuring tooltips remain readable in dense graph areas and fine-tuning spacing logic to prevent overlap in larger datasets.
