Determining how the results of the graph could be used in the summarization of the document and its important concepts

Kendrick Crespo:

Find ways to support of slow response times from third-party vendors.

What is planned to be done until the next scrum meeting?

Understand the unpredictable latency spikes, which affect the consistency of our application's user experience

What are the hurdles?

Difficulty reproducing the latency spikes in a controlled testing environment.

Jonathan Hernandez:

Finalized layout tweaks to improve how related nodes cluster together visually. Also cleaned up label positioning and adjusted tooltip timing to improve usability.

What is planned to be done until the next scrum meeting?
