Luis Gonzalez:

Outlined the expected structure for how chunked and cleaned text will be passed into the summarization module. Also drafted a basic input validation function to check for empty text.

Work on the validation step and prepare a small batch of test documents with intended formatting issues to see if the system can catch and clean them.

What are the hurdles?

Edge cases like scanned documents with large tables still need special handling strategies.

Worked on refining how the graph tools are used to create concept graphs and how to find the important words in a document

What is planned to be done until the next scrum meeting?

Keep working on making improvements on how the graph tools create graphs using important concepts and how the graph is displayed

What are the hurdles?

Determining how to improve the way the graphs could be presented to the user

Kendrick Crespo:**How many hours did I work since the last meeting?**

What was done since the last scrum meeting?

Understand the unpredictable latency spikes, which affect the consistency of our application's user experience

What is planned to be done until the next scrum meeting?

Figure out reproducing the latency spikes in a controlled testing environment.

What are the hurdles?

Existing monitoring tools may not provide granular enough data to trace exact latency sources.

Jonathan Hernandez:**How many hours did I work since the last meeting?**

What was done since the last scrum meeting?

Began connecting the graph component to preliminary summarization data. Successfully mapped key concepts to nodes and started testing how relationships are rendered in real scenarios.

What is planned to be done until the next scrum meeting?

Refine how edges are generated based on topic relationships and continue testing with different types of input files to assess flexibility.

What are the hurdles?

Handling inconsistent data structures from early summarization outputs and ensuring the graph remains clean and interpretable with varied input.
