Luis Gonzalez:

How many hours did I work since the last meeting?

What are the hurdles?

A few libraries require additional handling for edge cases (e.g., encoding issues, missing metadata).

How many hours did I work since the last meeting?

What was done since the last scrum meeting?

Tested the feedback submission flow with different types of input like valid ratings, empty comments, and edge cases like multiple rapid submissions. Verified that the data was saved correctly and consistently. Also sketched a rough plan for visualizing feedback trends, including charts for average ratings and most frequent keywords in comments.

What is planned to be done until the next scrum meeting?

Begin prototyping a basic dashboard view to display feedback statistics, starting with average summary ratings and feedback volume over time. Consider how this can support future model improvements.

What are the hurdles?

Designing a clean and simple visualization layout that's helpful without being overwhelming. Also figuring out how to highlight actionable insights, not just raw data.

David Peno:

Continue refining the organization of the nodes in the generated concept graphs and extracting the important concepts from a document

Being able to find relationships between concepts in a document and using them to create edges that link nodes together

Kendrick Crespo:

How many hours did I work since the last meeting?

What was done since the last scrum meeting?

Try to find potential delays caused by lack of standardized state management practices across the codebase

What is planned to be done until the next scrum meeting?

To find debugging tools that can provide clear insights into deeply nested or interconnected component trees.

What are the hurdles?

Jonathan Hernandez:

How many hours did I work since the last meeting?

What was done since the last scrum meeting?

Finalized real-time data flow into the graph and resolved sync timing issues that were affecting live updates. Also began outlining component documentation to assist with future development and integration.

What is planned to be done until the next scrum meeting?

Complete the documentation and assist in integrating the graph component into the broader application interface for testing.

What are the hurdles?

Minor delays in data formatting that require conditional handling before rendering; working on making the component more fault-tolerant.
