Accepted User Stories

User Story #18 – Real-Time Leaderboard

As a user, I want to see a real-time leaderboard ranking based on XP points. (Frontend + Backend)

User Story #12 – Gamification Visuals Final Pass

Finalized XP progress bar, badge unlock animation, and pop-up logic. All visuals approved after internal QA.

User Story #11 – Mobile UI Enhancements

Refined navigation for mobile users, including menu responsiveness and component spacing. (Frontend only)

User Story #9 – Session Stability Fixes

Addressed random logout issues by patching session management on the backend.

Deferred or Rejected User Stories

User Story #13 – Speech Recognition Practice (Final)

While largely functional, testing revealed inconsistencies in certain browser environments. Deferred for broader cross-platform QA.

User Story #17 – In-App Survey Pilot

UI template is complete, but backend data collection and feedback analysis components need more work. Moved to next sprint.
