The team presented the initial version of the web-based job scam detection tool. The current implementation includes a basic UI layout and some foundational code, but no full functionality has been completed yet.

The following user stories are in progress but were not yet completed:

- As a job seeker, I want to paste a job description into the website and get a scam detection result so that I can avoid suspicious job postings.
- As a developer, I want to design a simple UI layout with a text box, a button, and a result area so that users can interact with the tool.
- As a user, I want the tool to display a message when no suspicious content is detected so that I know the job is likely safe.
- As a developer, I want to write unit tests for the keyword detection logic so that we can ensure it works correctly.
- As a user, I want an "About" section on the site so that I can understand the purpose of the tool.
- As a developer, I want a simple CSS style for the website so that the layout is readable and user-friendly.
- As a user, I want to copy the scam analysis result to my clipboard so I can easily share it with others.

- As a user, I want the site to show a loading indicator while the analysis is running so that I know the tool is working.

No user stories were accepted during this sprint. The team aligned on priorities and expectations and will carry over the current work into the next sprint for further development and refinement.
