After discussion, the velocity of the team was estimated to be **17 story points**.

The product owner chose the following user stories to be done during the next sprint. They are ordered based on their priority.

1. As a job seeker, I want to paste a job description into the website and get a scam detection result so that I can avoid suspicious job postings.
 - a. Acceptance Criteria: Users can paste a job description, click "Analyze," and receive a result showing if it's suspicious or safe.
 - b. Story points: 5
2. As a developer, I want to design a simple UI with a text box, a button, and a result area so that users can interact with the tool.
 - a. Acceptance Criteria: The page has an input box, a button, and a section to show the results, styled with basic CSS.
 - b. Story points: 5
3. As a user, I want the tool to display a message when no suspicious content is detected so that I know the job is likely safe.
 - a. Acceptance Criteria: If no flagged keywords are found, a message like "No suspicious content detected" is shown.
 - b. Story points: 2
4. As a developer, I want to write unit tests for the detection logic so that we can make sure it works properly.
 - a. Acceptance Criteria: The logic is tested with flagged inputs, safe inputs, and edge cases.
 - b. Story points: 3
5. As a user, I want an "About" section on the site so I can understand what the tool does.
 - a. Acceptance Criteria: The site includes a short description explaining the purpose of Job Guard.

- b. Story points: 2
- 6. As a developer, I want to apply basic CSS so the site is clean and easy to read.
 - a. Acceptance Criteria: The layout uses readable fonts, spacing, and button styling.
 - b. Story points: 3
- 7. As a user, I want to see a loading indicator while the analysis runs so I know it's working.
 - a. Acceptance Criteria: A spinner or loading message is shown while the result is being processed.
 - b. Story points: 3
- 8. As a user, I want to be able to block the offending poster from my feed so I am less likely to encounter that poster again.
 - a. Acceptance Criteria: A list of blocked posters that will trigger a pop up if the user is close to interacting with a previously identified fraudulent listing.
 - b. Story points: 2
