After discussion, the velocity of the team was estimated to be **45 story points**.

The product owner chose the following user stories to be done during the next sprint. They are ordered based on their priority.

- 1. As a job seeker, I want to paste or upload a job listing (URL or text) so that the system can analyze it for fraud.**
 - a. Acceptance Criteria: Given I supply a valid job listing link or paste job text, When I click "Analyze," Then the system initiates analysis and shows a loading indicator. Given analysis completes successfully, Then I see a summary result. Given an invalid or empty input, Then I see an error message prompting a correct input.
 - b. Story Points: 5**
- 2. As a user, I want a dashboard showing summary risk levels (Low / Medium / High) so that I can quickly assess listings.**
 - a. Acceptance Criteria: Given I have analyzed multiple listings, Then the dashboard displays each with a date, source, and risk level badge. Summary risk levels are consistent with backend logic.
 - b. Story Points: 4**
- 3. As a job seeker, I want to view detailed explanations of each fraud indicator so I understand why a listing was flagged.**
 - a. Acceptance Criteria: For each flagged listing, a "View Details" link reveals red-flag reasons (e.g. "Generic email domain," "Excessive salary claim"). Indicators are clearly worded and user-friendly.
 - b. Story Points: 5**
- 4. As a user, I want to submit feedback (e.g. false positive or confirming fraud) so the system improves.**

- a. Acceptance Criteria: Given I click “Feedback,” Then I see options and can submit. My feedback is stored and confirmation is shown.
 - b. Story Points: 4**
- 5. As an admin/researcher, I want to review flagged listings and feedback so I can improve detection algorithms.**
 - a. Acceptance Criteria: Admin panel lists flagged listings with user feedback. I can mark feedback as “useful” or “dismiss,” with status persistence.
 - b. Story Points: 6**
- 6. As a job seeker, I want to save analyzed listings to a personal list so I can track or revisit them later.**
 - a. Acceptance Criteria: Clicking “Save” on a listing adds it to “Saved Listings.” I can view and remove items in the saved list.
 - b. Story Points: 3**
- 7. As a user, I want to filter listings by risk level, date added, or source so I can prioritize follow-ups.**
 - a. Acceptance Criteria: Filters appear on dashboard. Applying filters updates the listing view accordingly.
 - b. Story Points: 4**
- 8. As a job seeker, I want to receive optional email summaries or notification digests of new high-risk saved listings.**
 - a. Acceptance Criteria: I can toggle email or in-app notifications in settings. If toggled on, I receive a summary within 24 hours of a new high-risk entry in my saved list.
 - b. Story Points: 5**
- 9. As a user, I want to see anonymized examples of real fraudulent job ads so I can learn how to spot them independently.**
 - a. Acceptance Criteria: A resource page includes at least 3 anonymized examples with descriptions. Each example highlights the key fraudulent characteristic (e.g. unrealistic salary, poor grammar).
 - b. Story Points: 4**
- 10. As a job seeker, I want to whitelist trusted company emails or domains, so legitimate listings don’t trigger alerts.**
 - a. Acceptance Criteria: Settings allow adding domains or email addresses to a whitelist. Listings from whitelisted sources bypass fraud checks or show “trusted” status. Saved whitelist persists between sessions.
 - b. Story Points: 5**
