The main homepage is intended for loved ones to locate individuals. Users must enter the evacuee's full name and date of birth. If a match is found, a new screen will display the evacuee's information and the shelter location.

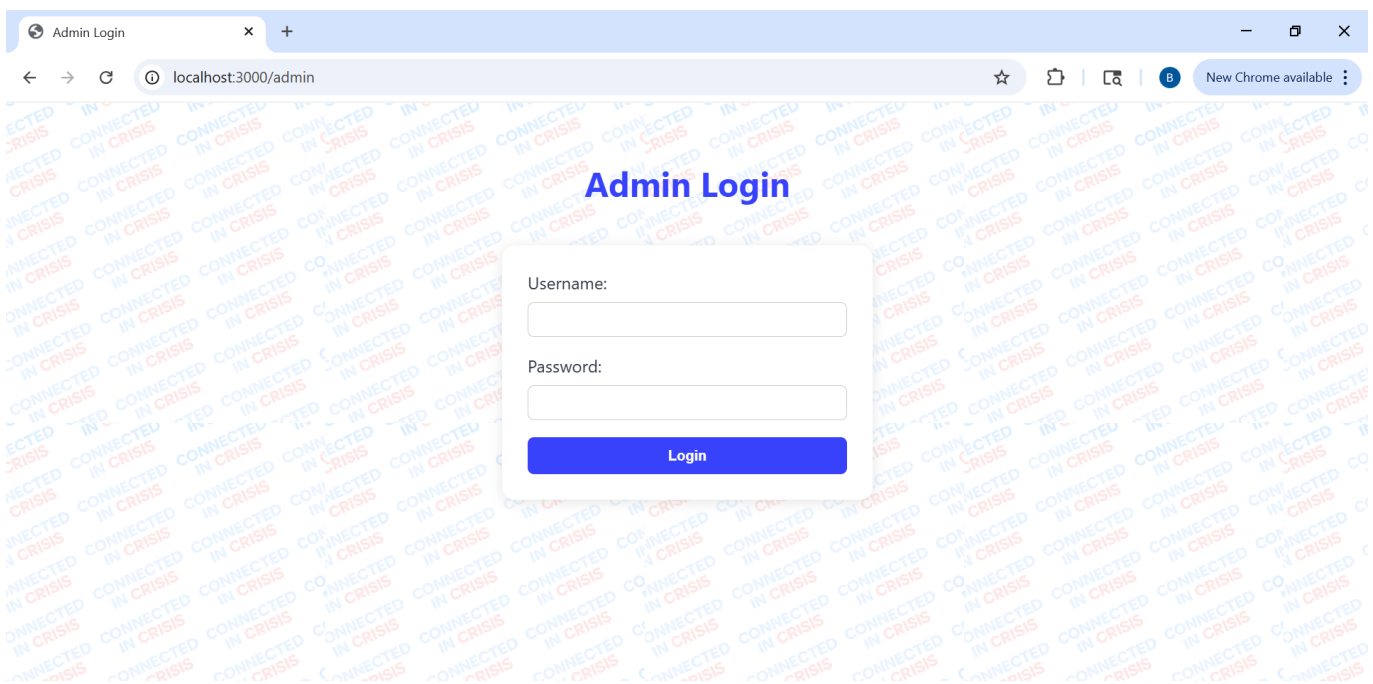

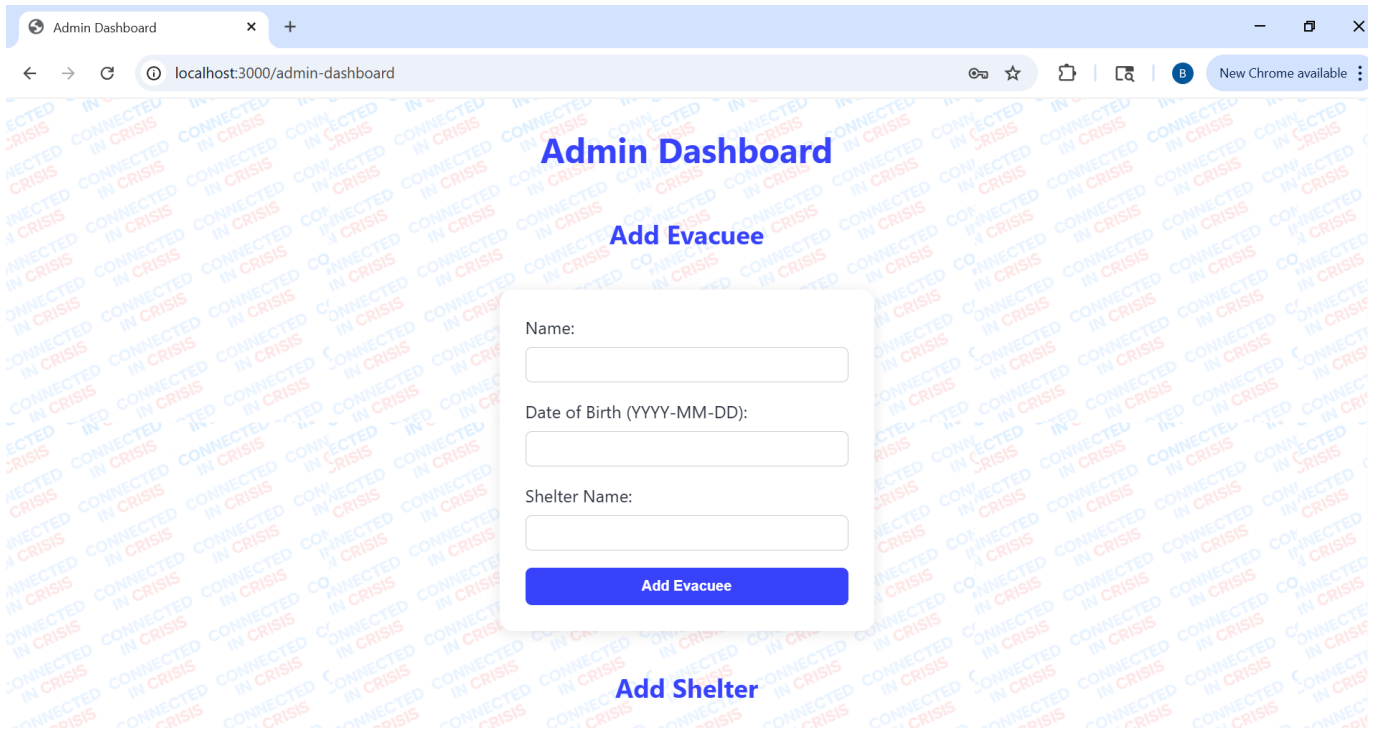
Admin Features

Admins can log in via the Admin Login page to manage records. Once logged in:

- They can add new evacuees by providing name, DOB, and shelter name.
- They can add new shelters by entering shelter name and address.
- They can delete evacuees, but must confirm the evacuee's name and DOB to complete deletion.

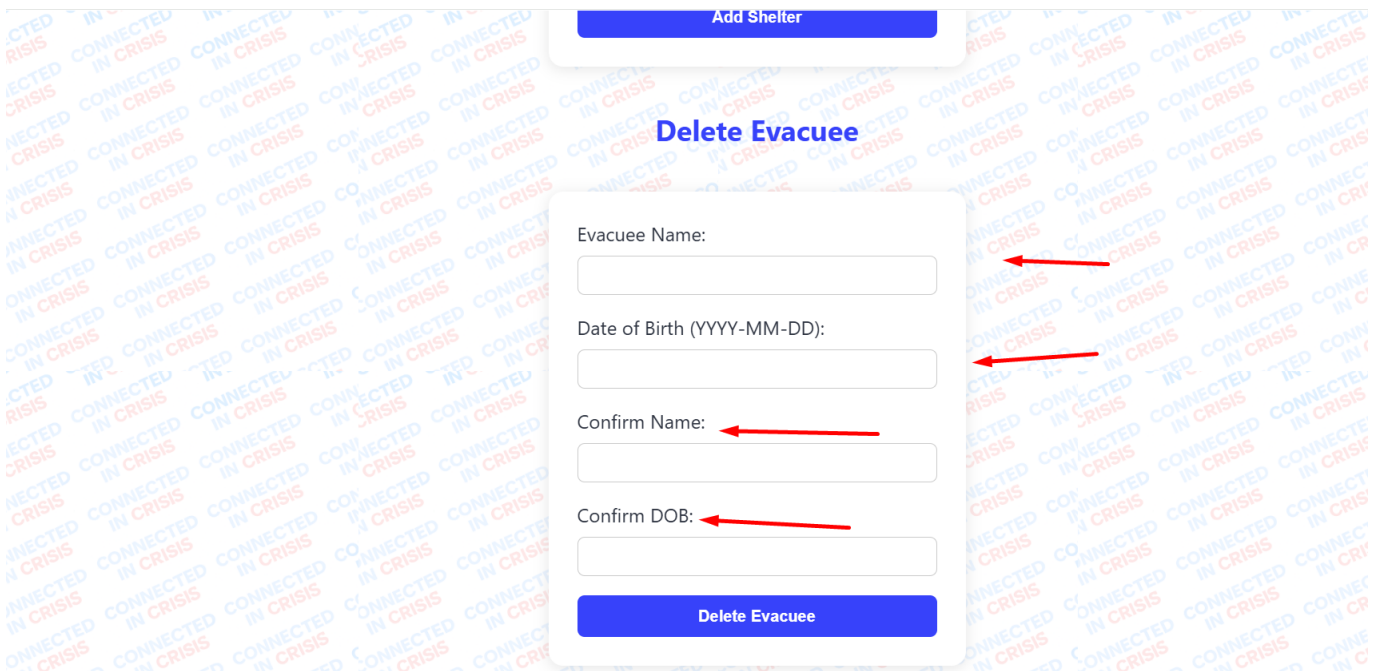

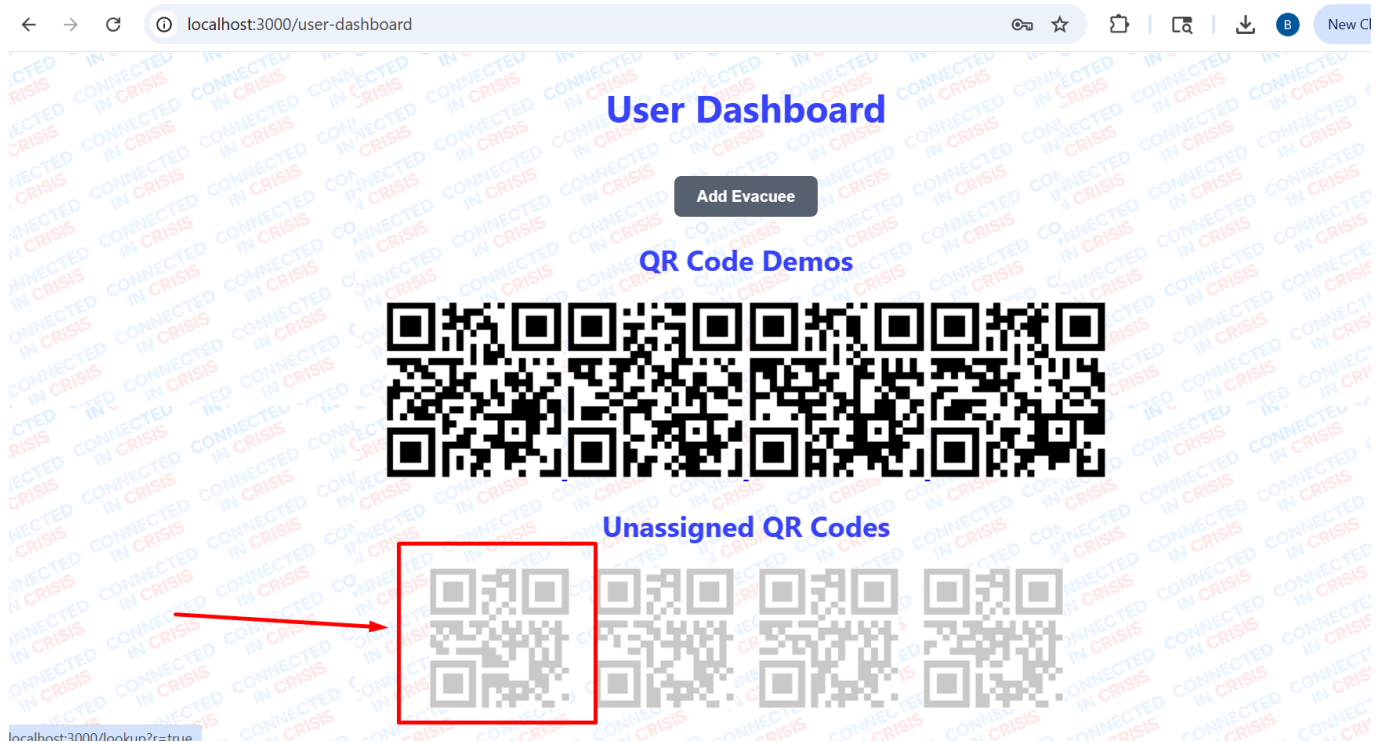
QR Code Integration

The system uses two types of QR codes:

- Black QR codes: Represent already loaded wristbands. These are used for evacuees who are already in the system, such as during shelter transfers or quick identification.

- Grey QR codes: Represent unassigned wristbands. Clicking one leads to a form that allows the user to input and assign a new evacuee to that wristband.
