- Reviewed all pull requests (PRs) and code changes in GitHub giving constructive feedback and enforcing industry standard practices

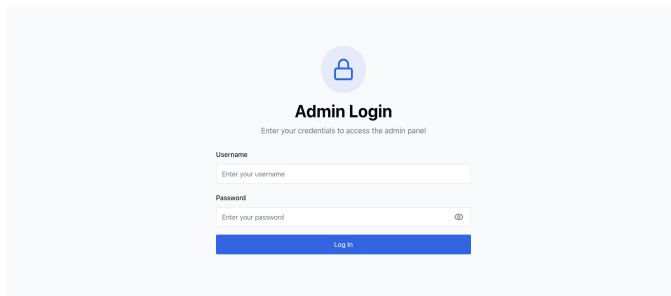

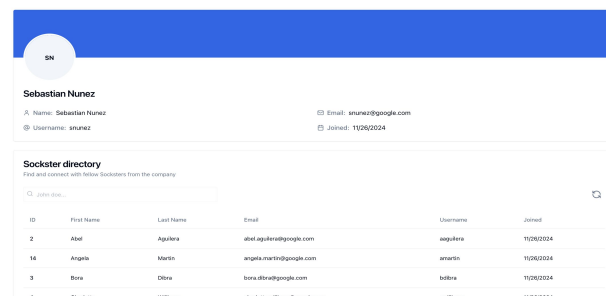

INDIVIDUAL CONTRIBUTIONS

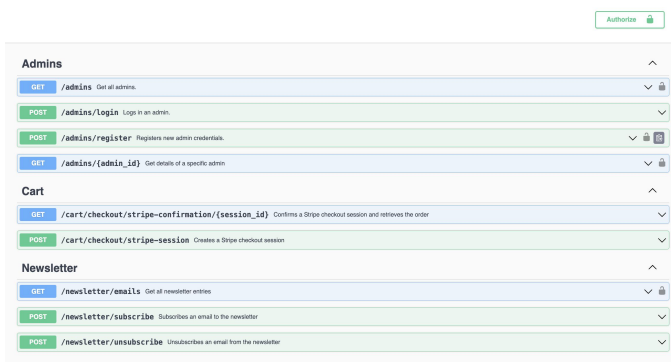
- Developed the bulk of the Auth framework and UI that powers and safeguards our app and API

- Added support for dark and light themes throughout the app



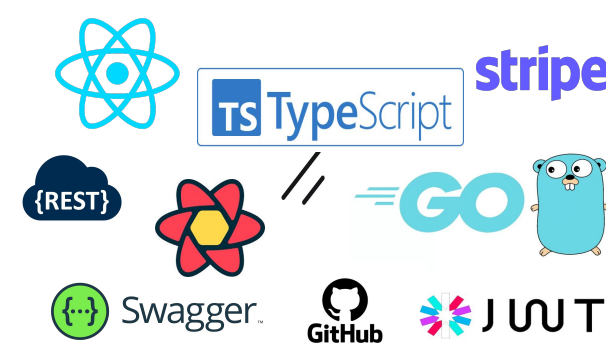
Auth UI
