The product owner chose the following user stories to be done during the next sprint. They are ordered based on their priority.

User Story 1: Pet Profile Setup

- **As a** pet owner,
- **I want** to create a profile for my pet with basic details (name, age, breed, and photo),
- **So that** I can easily keep track of my pet's information in one place.

Acceptance Criteria:

- The user can upload a profile picture.
- The user can input basic pet information (name, breed, age).
- The profile page is easily accessible from the home screen.

User Story 2: Home Screen Navigation

- **As a** pet owner,
- **I want** to easily navigate the home screen with clear buttons or icons,
- **So that** I can access key features like my pet's profile, health tracker, and alerts.

Acceptance Criteria:

- The home screen displays icons for main features (Pet Profile, Health Tracker, Lost Pet Alert, etc.).
- Buttons are large and easily clickable.
- The user can navigate between screens using a bottom or side navigation bar.

User Story 3: Add Appointment

- **As a** pet owner,
- **I want** to add a vet appointment to my calendar,
- **So that** I can stay organized and track upcoming health events for my pet.

Acceptance Criteria:

- The user can add an appointment through a calendar view or form.
- The appointment details (vet name, date, time) are easy to input and edit.
- The user can see upcoming appointments displayed on the dashboard or calendar.
