The product owner chose the following user stories to be done during the next sprint. They are ordered based on their priority.

User Story 1: Account Dashboard

- **Title:** As a user, I want an account dashboard that provides an overview of my account activity, so I can easily access and manage my information.
- **Acceptance Criteria:**
 - The dashboard displays account details such as username, profile picture, and recent activities.
 - Users can navigate to sections like account settings, billing information, and notifications from the dashboard.
 - The dashboard provides alerts or notifications about any updates or pending actions.

User Story 2: Login/Sign-Up Page

- **Title:** As a new or returning user, I want a login/sign-up page that is simple and secure, so I can access my account or create a new one with ease.
- **Acceptance Criteria:**
 - The page provides options to either log in with an existing account or sign up for a new account.
 - The login requires email/username and password inputs, with an option to reset the password if forgotten.
 - The sign-up form requires basic information such as name, email, and password, with form validation to ensure data accuracy.
 - Social media login options (e.g., Google, Facebook) are available.
 - Error messages are displayed for invalid login or sign-up attempts.

User Story 3: Database Configuration

- **Title:** As a developer, I want a structured and optimized database configuration to store user data and support application features efficiently.
- **Acceptance Criteria:**
 - The database is configured to store user account information, login history, and dashboard-related data.
 - Appropriate tables and relationships are created for handling users, settings, notifications, and billing information.
 - Data validation and security measures (e.g., encryption for passwords) are implemented in the configuration.
 - The database allows for scalability to accommodate a growing number of users.
