

Cybersecurity Training Platform Shortcoming and Wishlist

Shortcomings:

1. Lack of User Authentication: The platform doesn't implement any user authentication, meaning anyone with access to the browser could potentially retrieve or overwrite the uniqueID stored in localStorage.

Example: If two users share the same computer, the second user could overwrite the first user's progress and certificate ID.

2. No Progress Visualization: Users cannot see an overview of their progress across modules, aside from manually counting completed modules.

Example: Adding a progress bar or dashboard to show the percentage of completed modules would make tracking progress easier.

3. Limited Quiz Functionality: The quiz component assumes that quizzes are static and cannot dynamically change based on user input or adapt to user knowledge.

Example: A quiz could adjust its difficulty based on correct or incorrect answers to better suit the user's skill level.

4. No Mobile-Specific Optimizations: While Tailwind CSS provides a responsive layout, there are no mobile-specific adjustments to ensure an optimal user experience on smaller screens.

Example: The quiz buttons may be too small or closely spaced for users on mobile devices, leading to poor usability.

Wishlist:

1. User Authentication System: Add user login and account functionality to securely store and retrieve progress and certificates.

Example: Users could log in with email and password, allowing progress to sync across devices.

2. Gamification Elements: Introduce badges, leaderboards, or rewards for completing modules to make the platform more engaging.

Example: Users earn a "Phishing Master" badge after completing the Social Engineering module.

3. Advanced Analytics: Include an admin dashboard to monitor user progress and performance across modules.

Example: An admin could view the average score for quizzes or see which modules users find most challenging.
