Alex Castaneira:

- How many hours did I work since the last meeting?
 - I have worked 3 hours since the last meeting, the first meeting of week 2 in sprint 6 during week 13.
- What was done since the last scrum meeting?
 - Since our last meeting I have continued working with others on the code regarding implementation for the Java side programs. This includes the export java side in which graphing information of the points will be sent to the txt file. We have met with Professor Hernandez and determined next tasks to do regarding changes in which we are starting to develop with showcase and deadline in mind.
- What is planned to be done until the next scrum meeting?
 - We have met with Professor Hernandez and determined next tasks to do regarding changes in which will develop the final needed imports for C++ side and exports for the Java side. We also have a goal to start developing a simple graph showcase of 2D triangulation or voronoi diagram of simple object while waiting for Mr. Hernandez to give the full library. Another hurdle is testing graphical implementations to check properly since we are lacking the libraries that will be used in showcase so we have created substitute libraries. Another hurdle is the time constraint of one week left while still waiting for final library implementation to use in displaying.
