What went wrong?

- Did we do a good job estimating our team's velocity?
 - The velocity of the team was good, but conflicts with school (classes, exams, etc.) slightly inhibited our ability to communicate as a team.
- Did we do a good job estimating the points (time required) for each user story?
 - We definitely could have done a better job estimating the time required for each story. Given it's near the end of the semester, we've had to focus on exams and midterms, which inhibited our ability to work on the project. We definitely should have accounted for this during the sprint planning meeting
- Did each team member work as scheduled?
 - Yes, each team member attended the daily sprints and delivered on their assigned user stories.

What went right?.

- Our communication through the daily meetings has been imperative to the success of the sprint, and so far the agile development method has proved extremely successful.
- Good progress has been made on planning the graph database schema and questionnaire form to upload materials
