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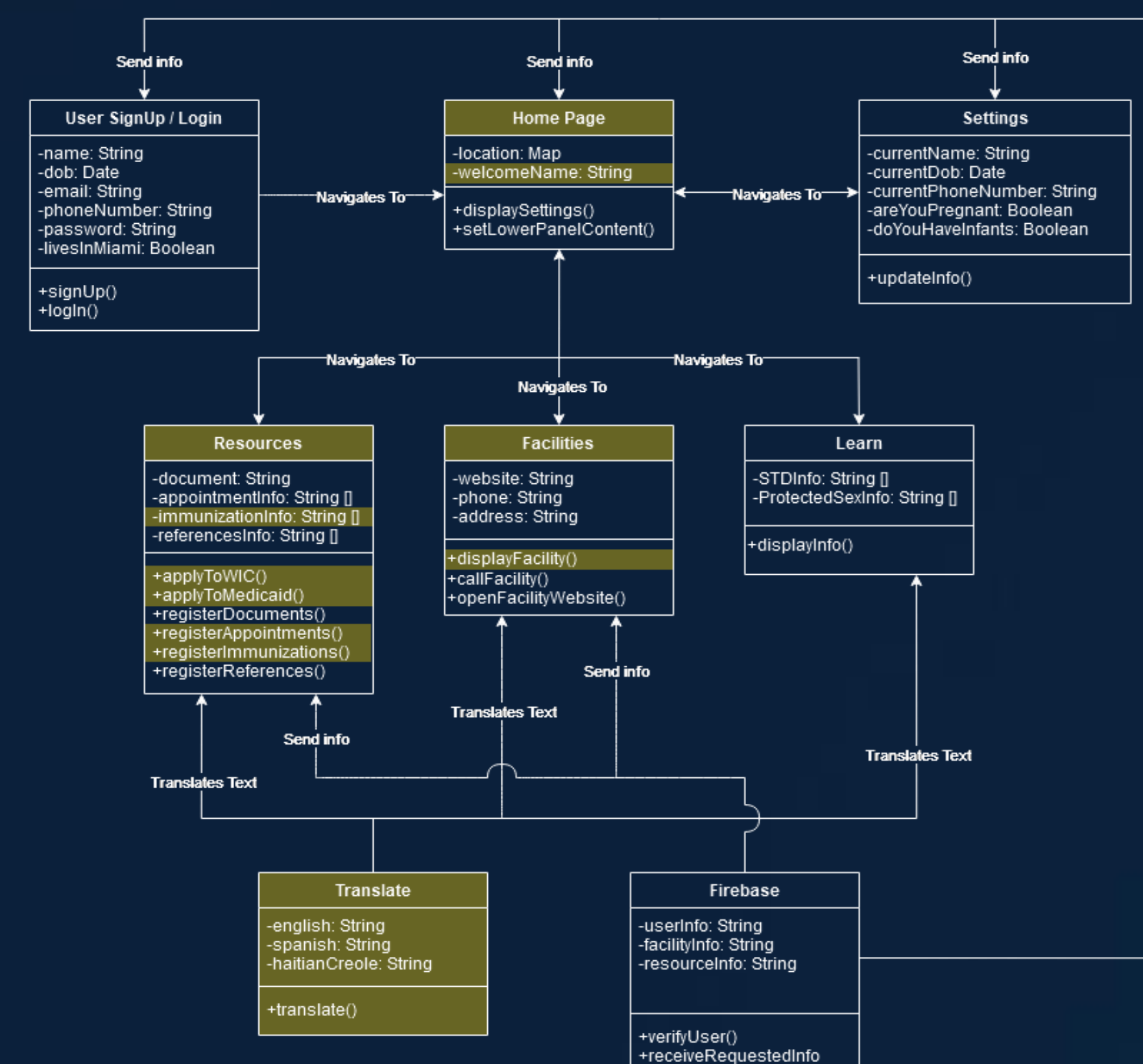
REQUIREMENTS

- I ended up formatting the feeding page which had too much spacing making the words hard to read, making it easier to read.

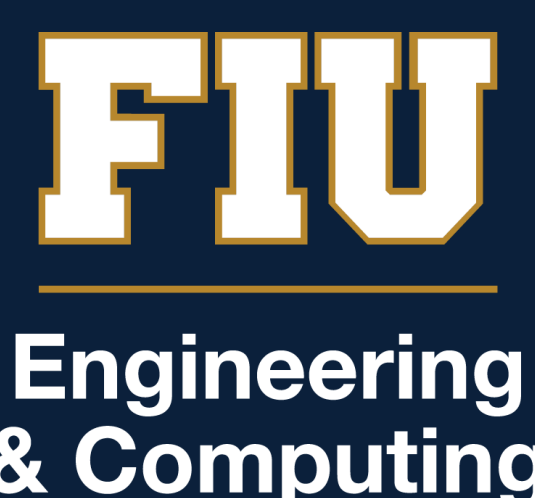
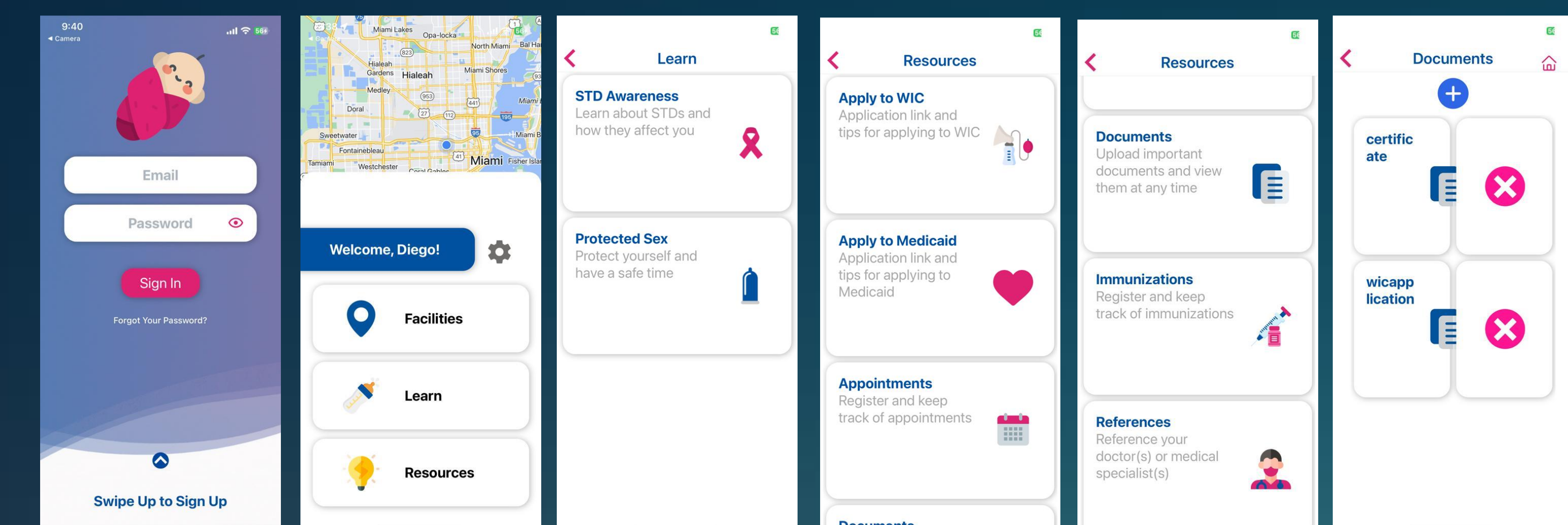
IMPLEMENTATIONS
