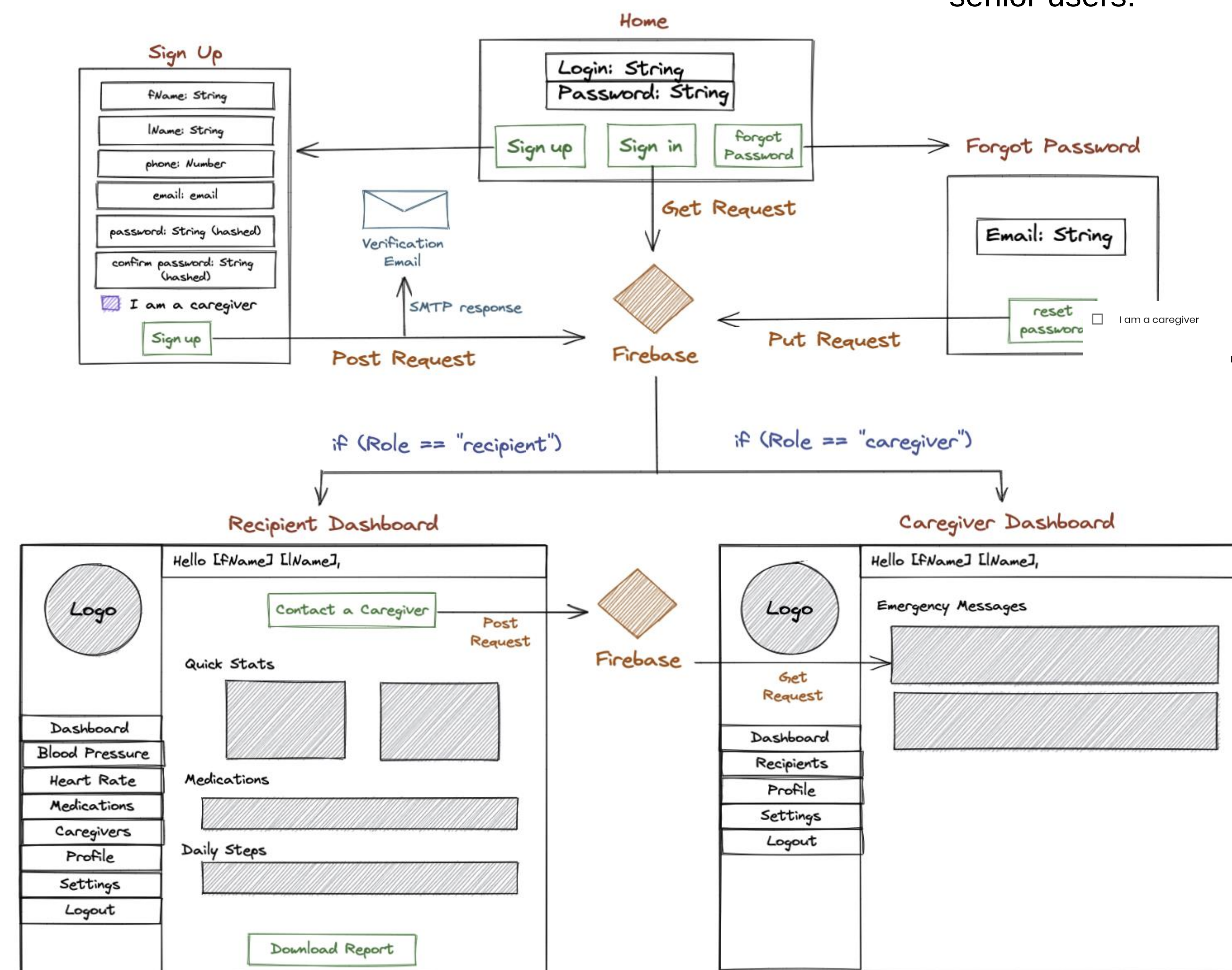
GOAL

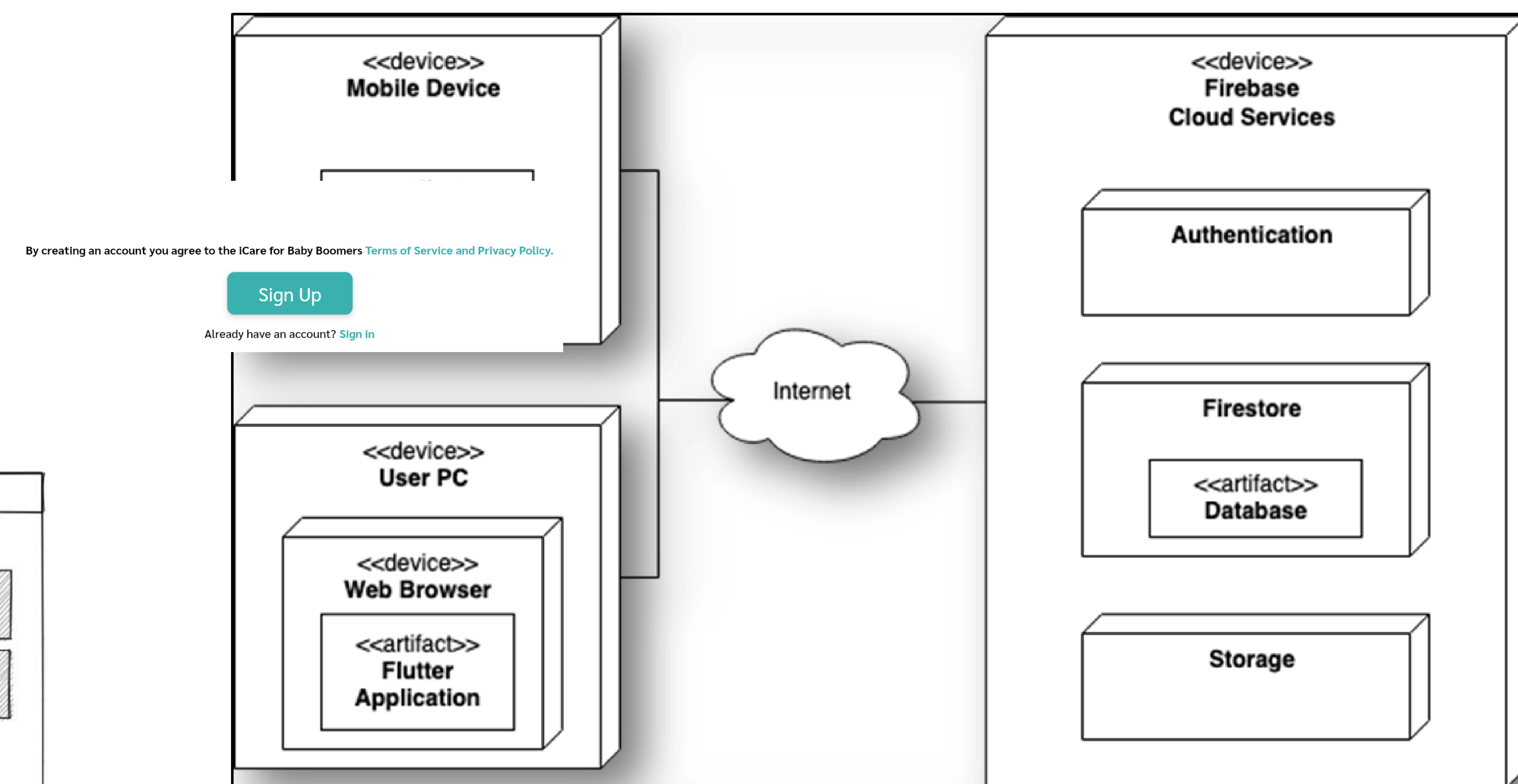
IMPLEMENTATIONS
