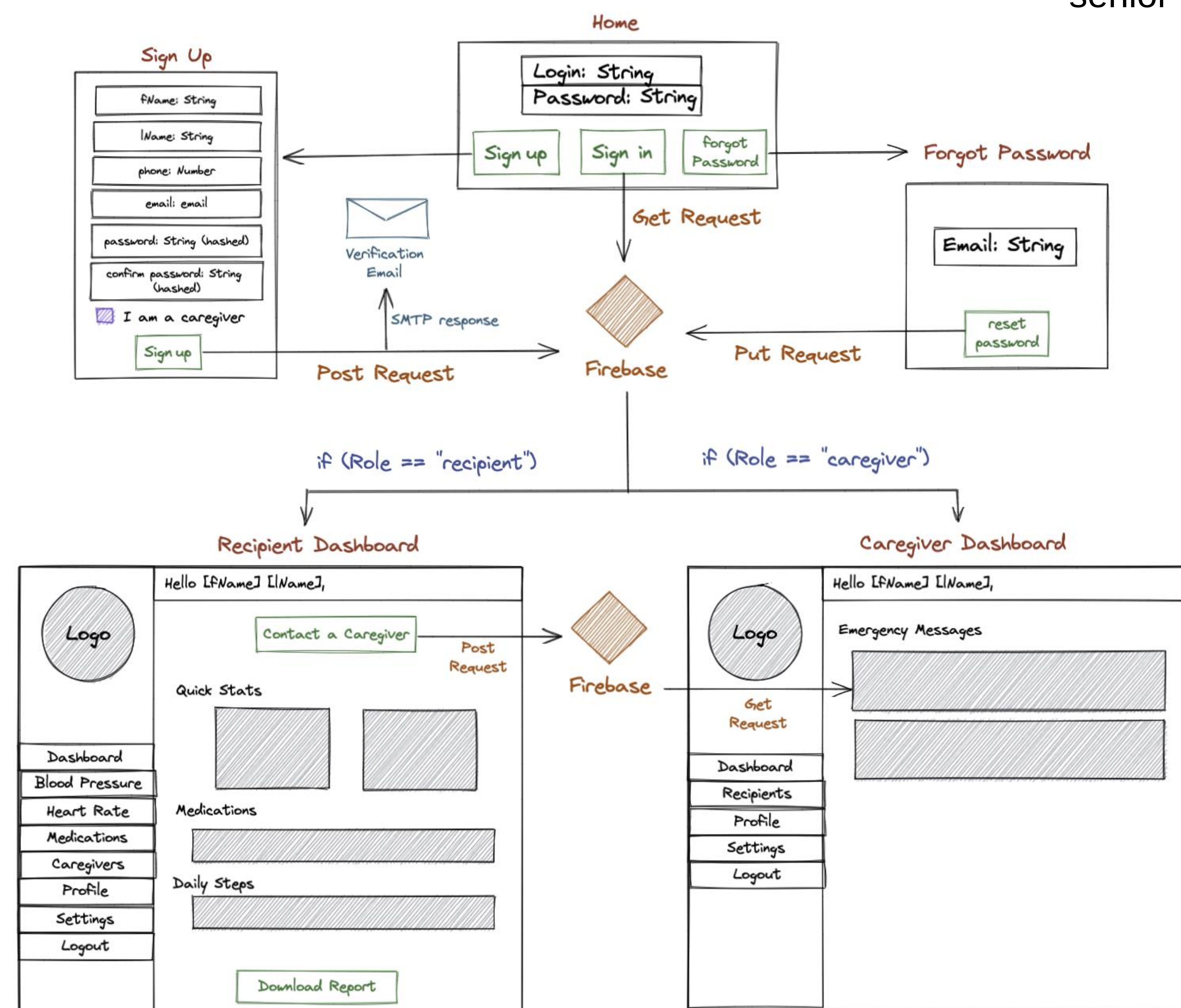


PROBLEM

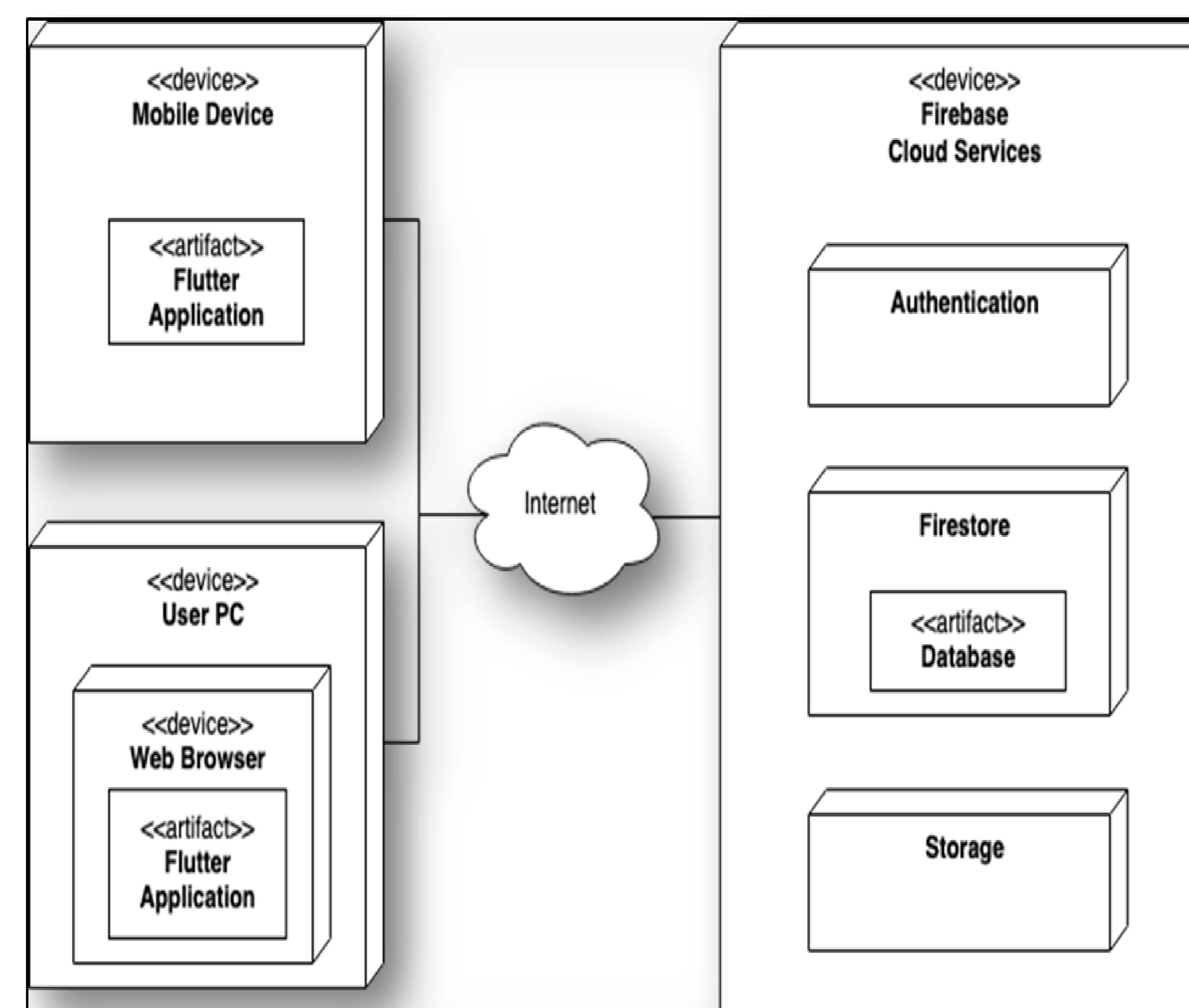
PROCESS DIAGRAM

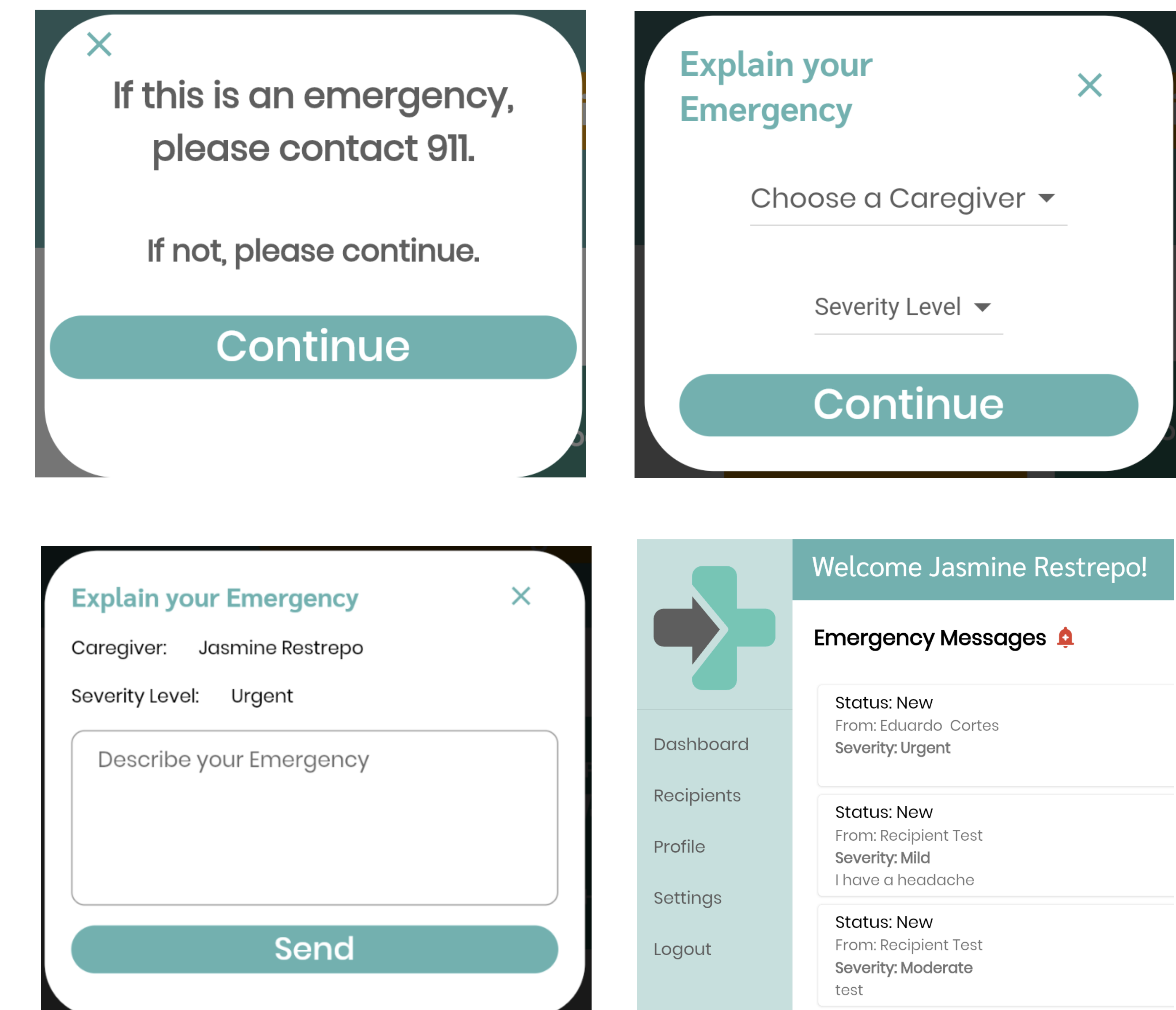
DEPLOYMENT DIAGRAM

- Insuring users' privacy.

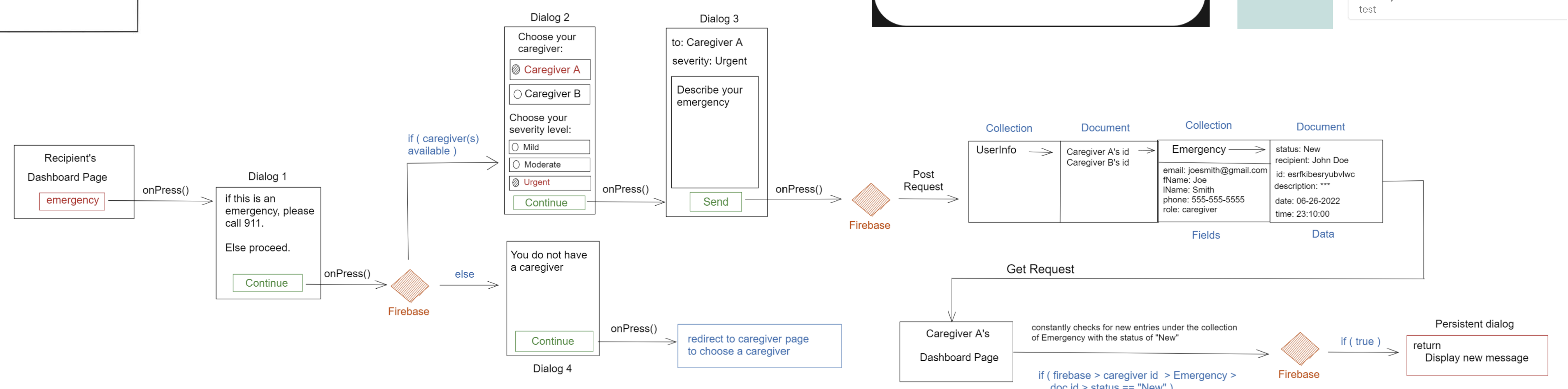
