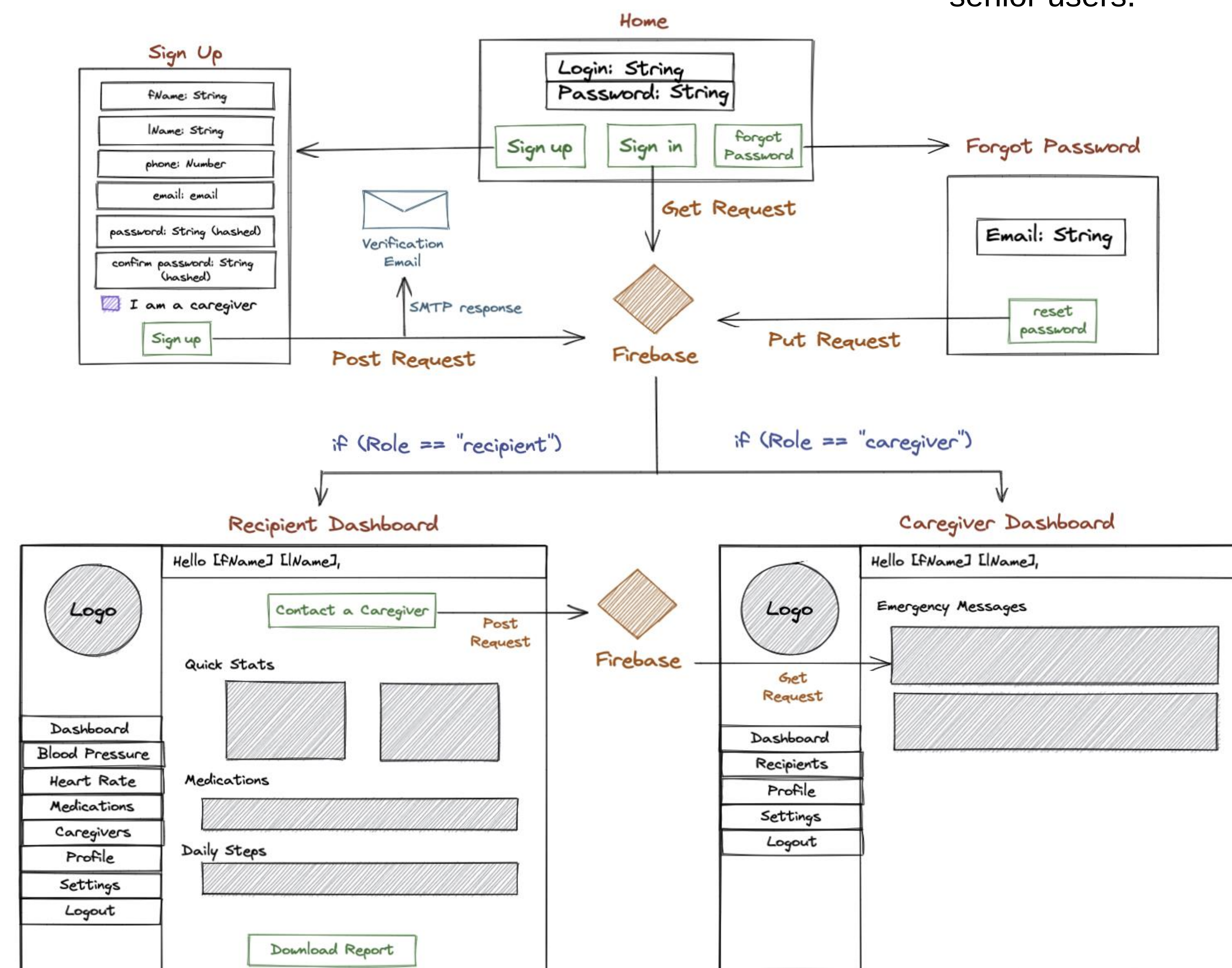
GOAL

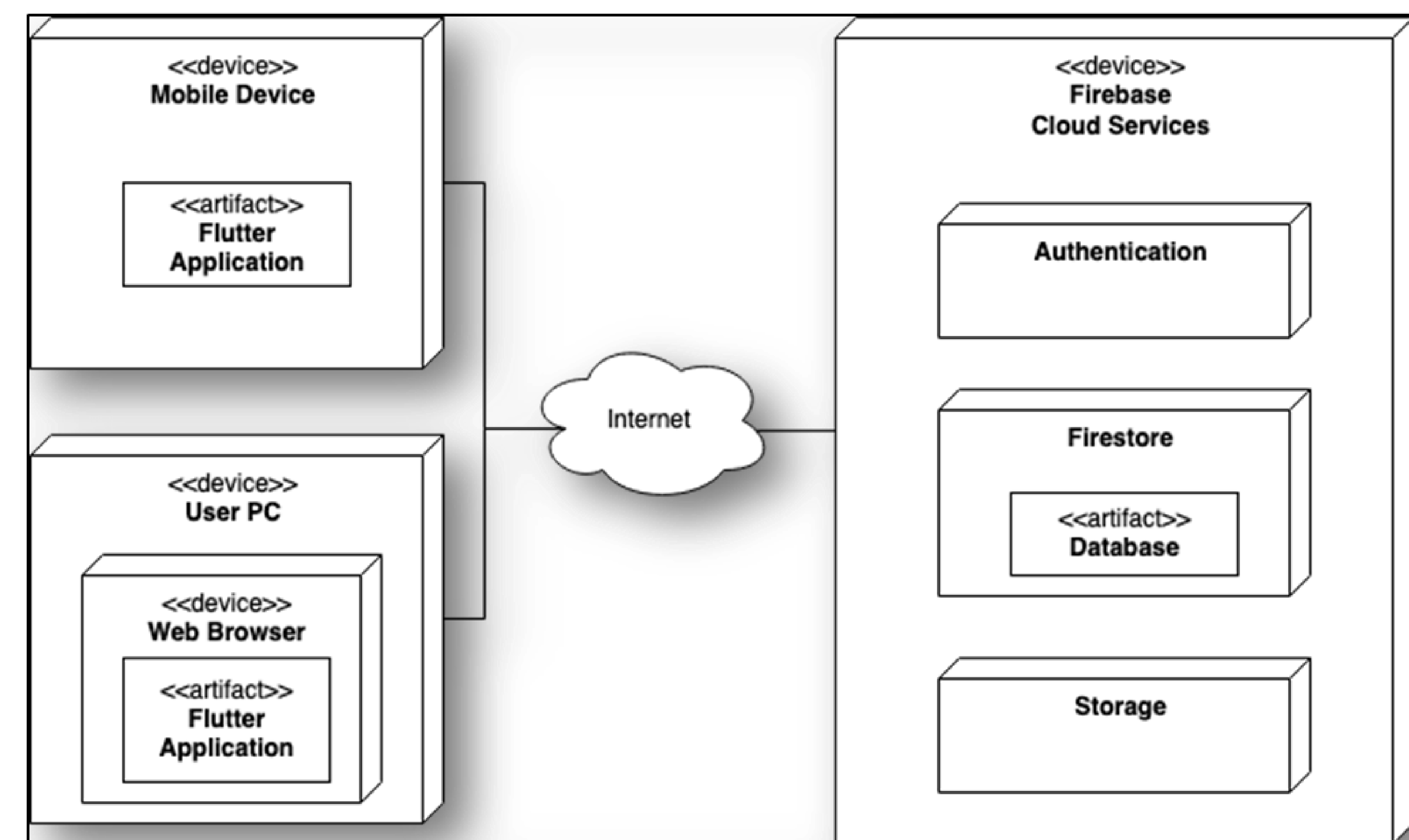
IMPLEMENTATIONS

The following features have been added to the profile page:

Update email – A user can modify his/her email after the process sends the user an e-mail to verify the email's authenticity.

Emergency Contact – A user can add, modify or delete a contact. Furthermore, a user can place a call through an Android mobile device.

Address – A user can add, modify or delete an address.
