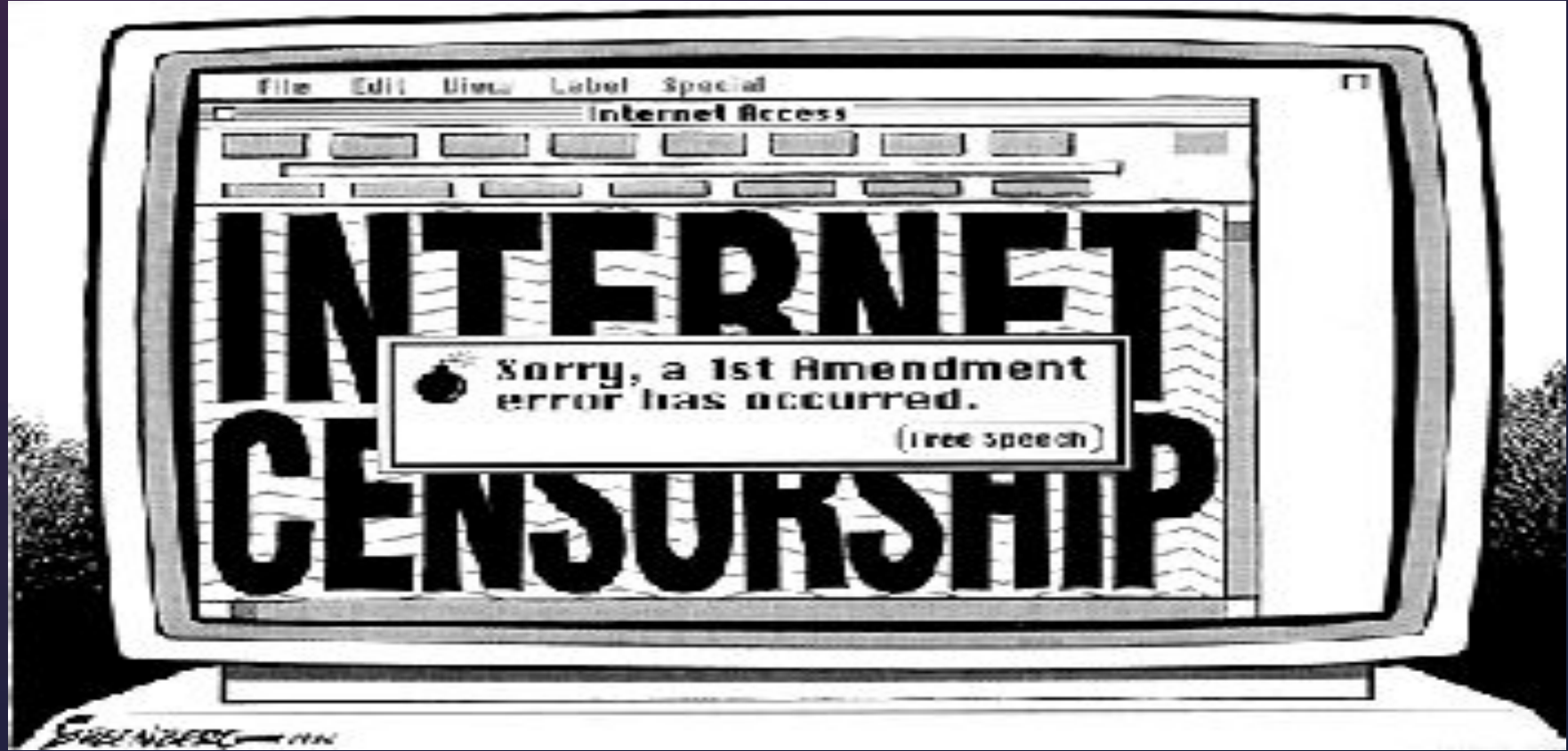

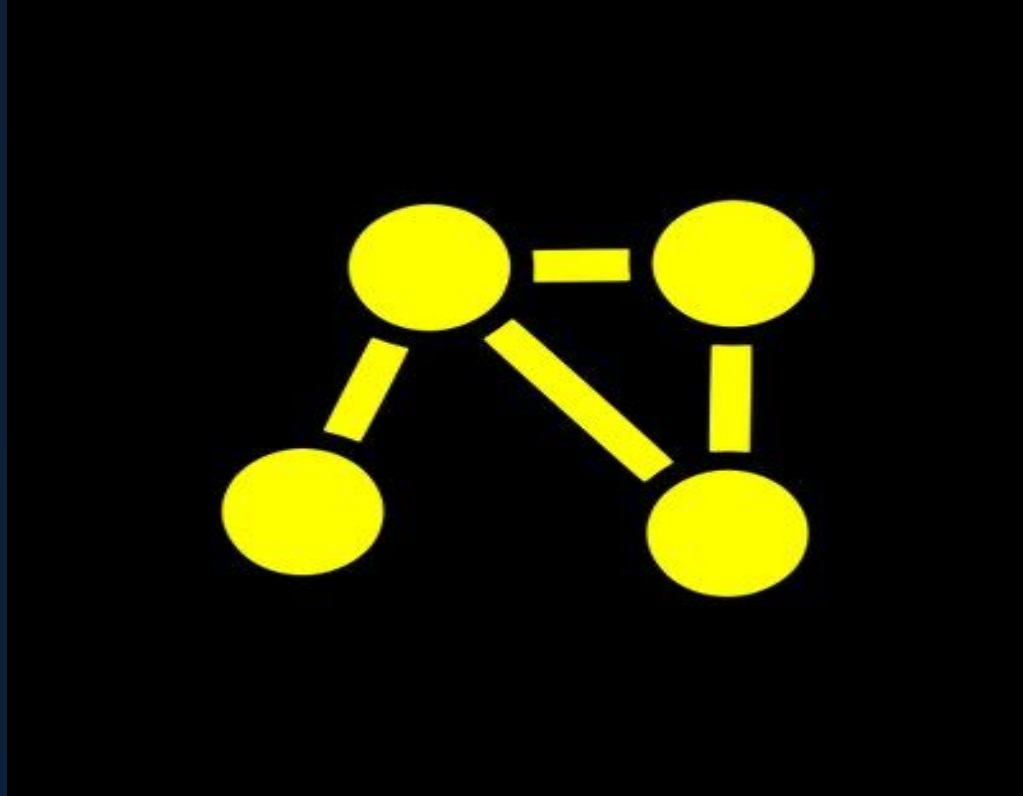
PROBLEM

Currently the app connects to twitter account @netblocks to inform users of data and internet interruptions on large scales

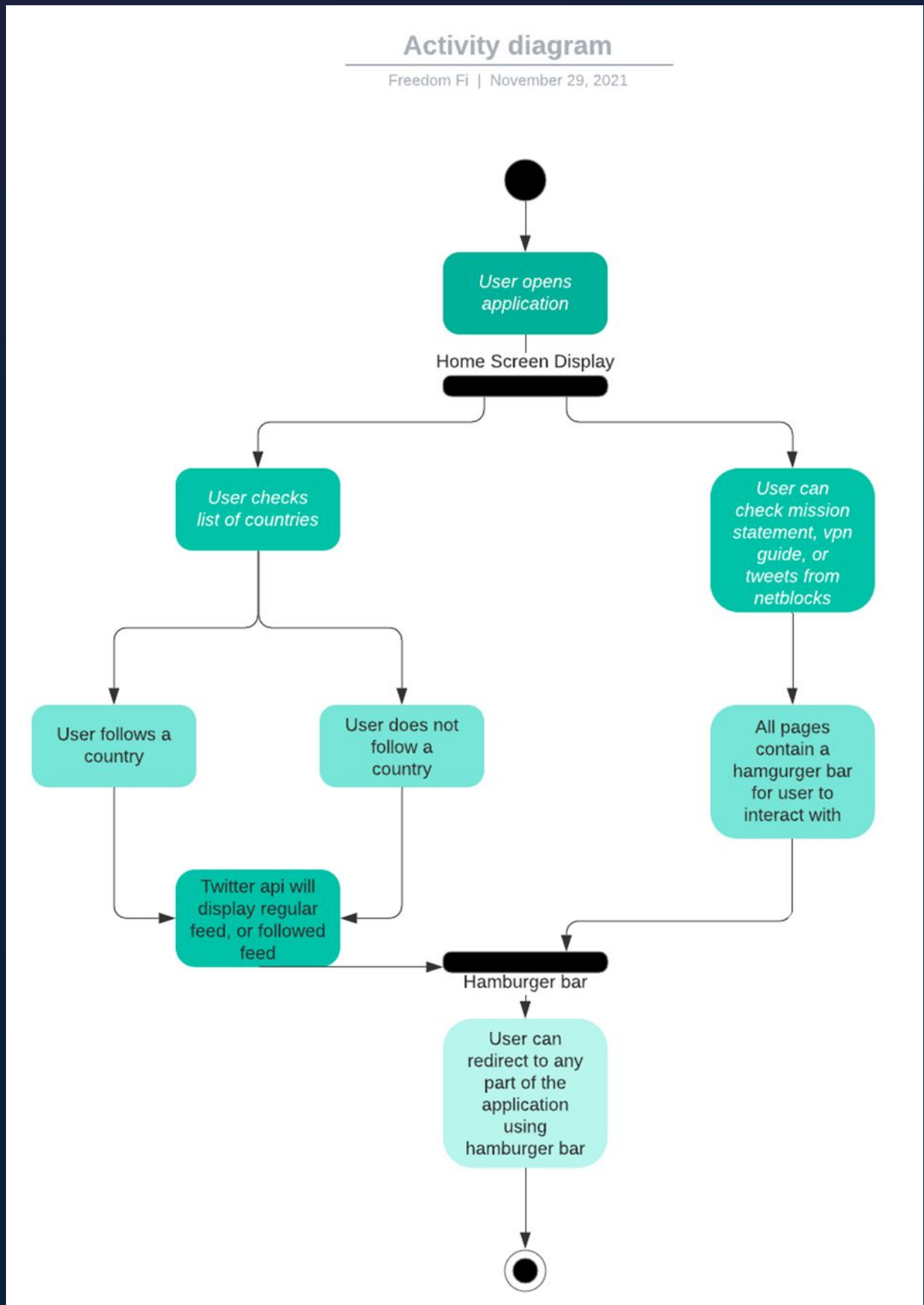


REQUIREMENTS

- Flutter SDK



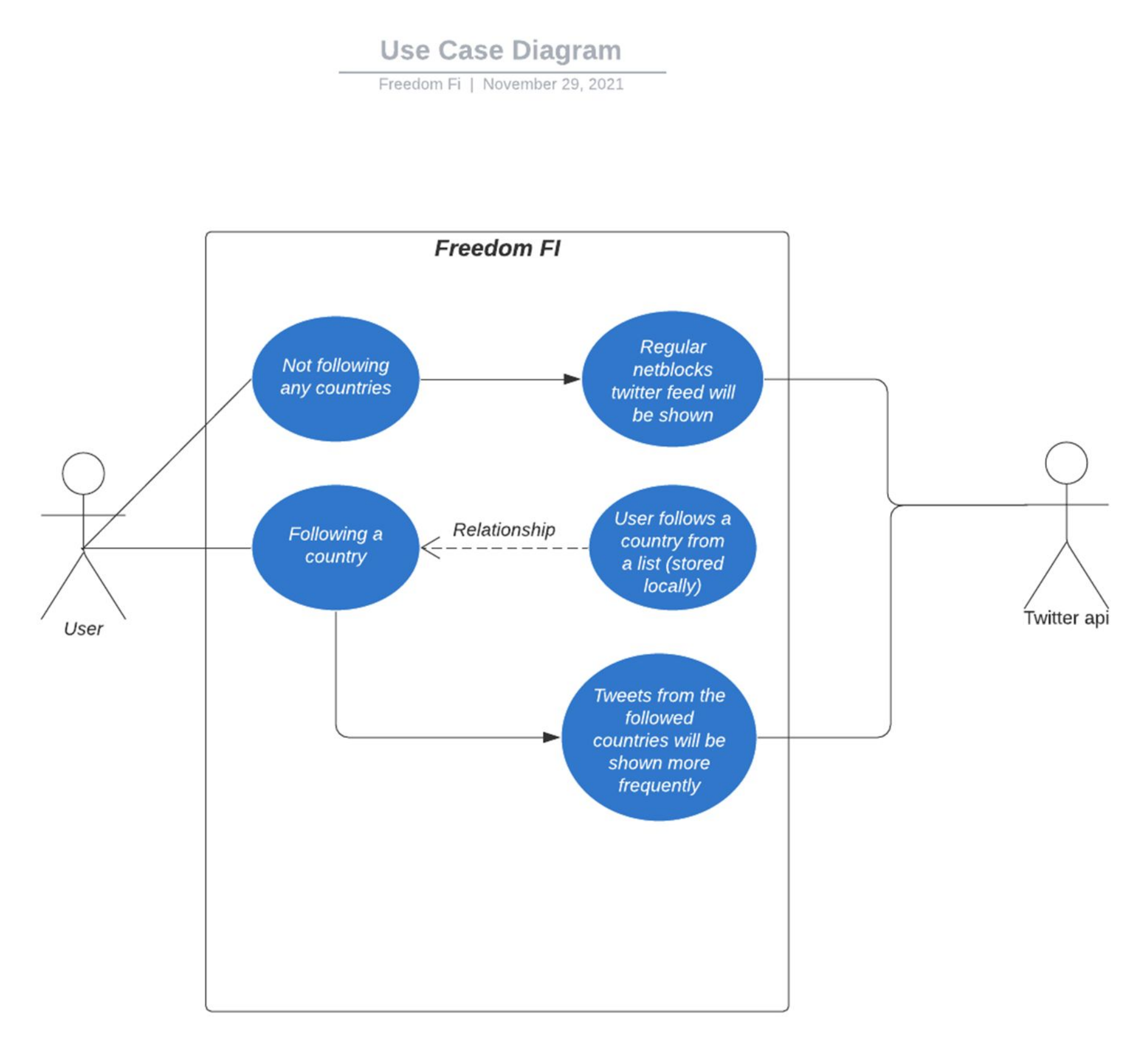
SYSTEM DESIGN
