

Installation Guide

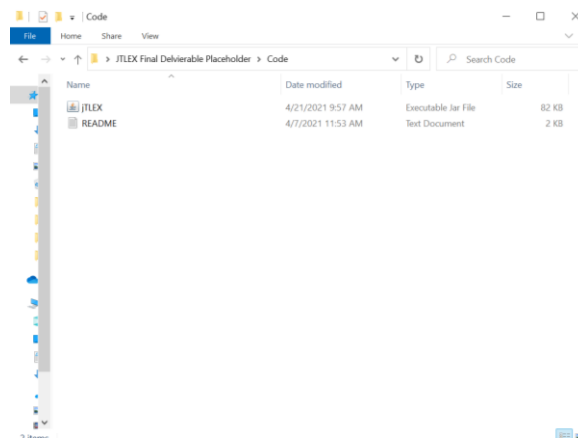
jTLEX is a java library for timeline extraction, as jTLEX is a java library the process in which to install the java library requires only a small number of steps.

The following are the steps for how to install and make use of the jTLEX java library:

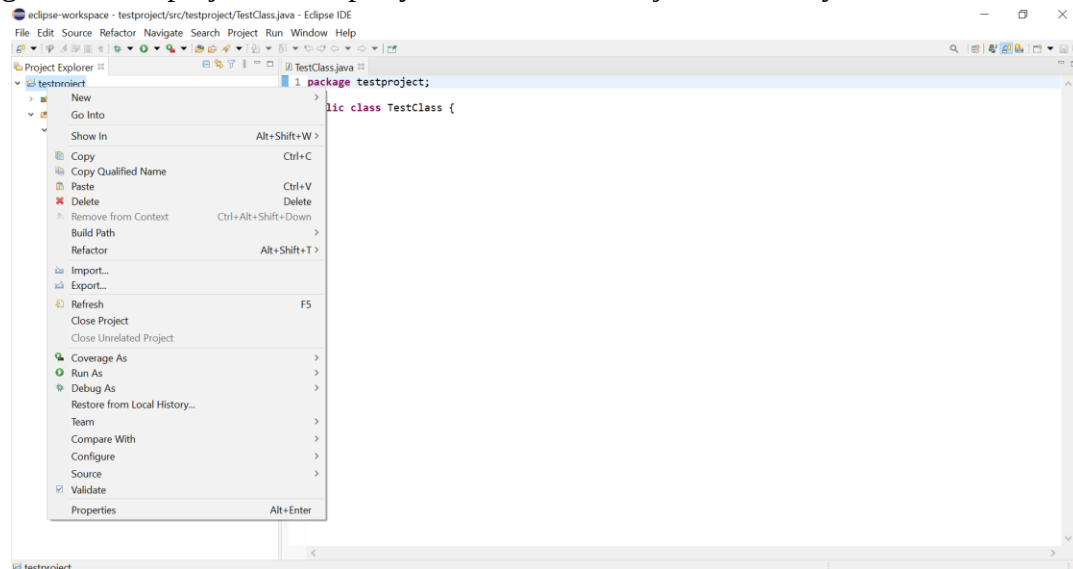
1. Download the jTLEX jar file to your computer.
2. Load the jTLEX jar file into your java IDE of choice.
3. Add the jar file to your class path.

The following will demonstrate the installation process of jTLEX for the Eclipse java IDE:

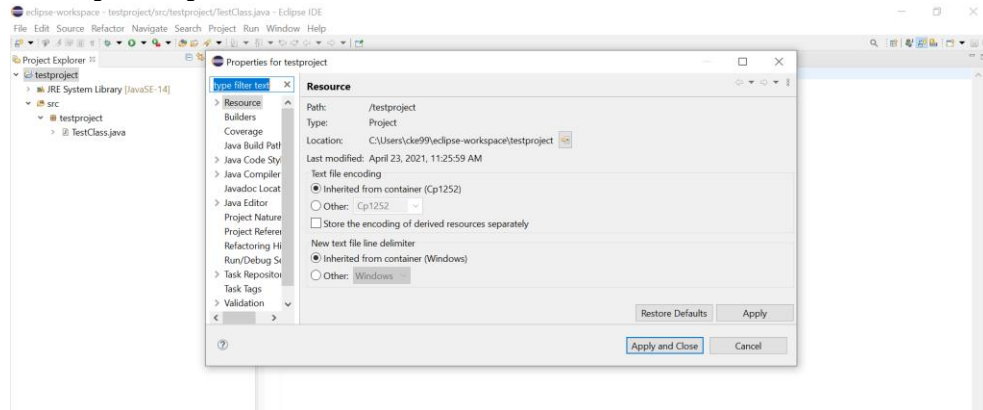
1. Download the jTLEX jar file somewhere on your computer.



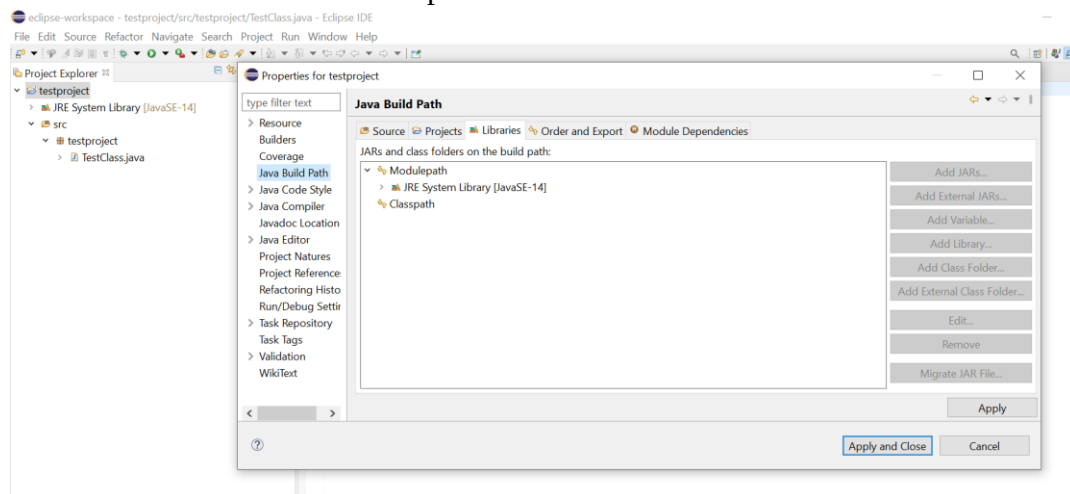
2. Right click the project in Eclipse you wish to use the jTLEX library within.



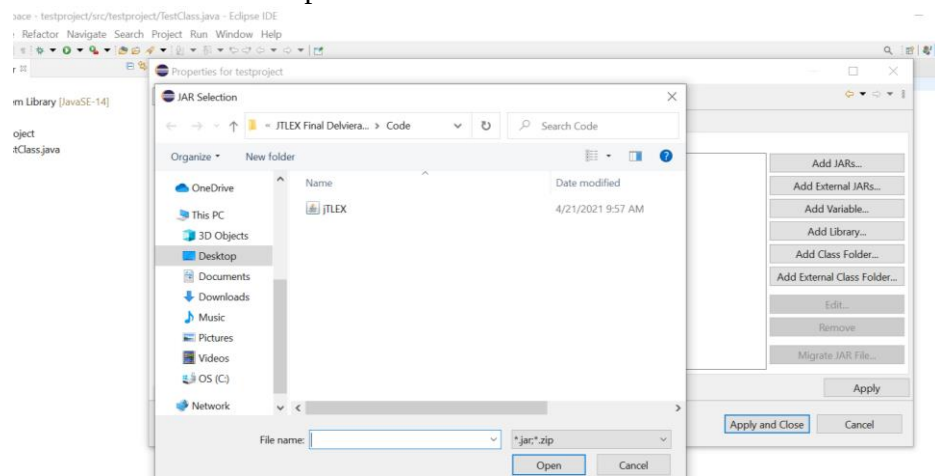
3. Open the Properties portion of the menu.



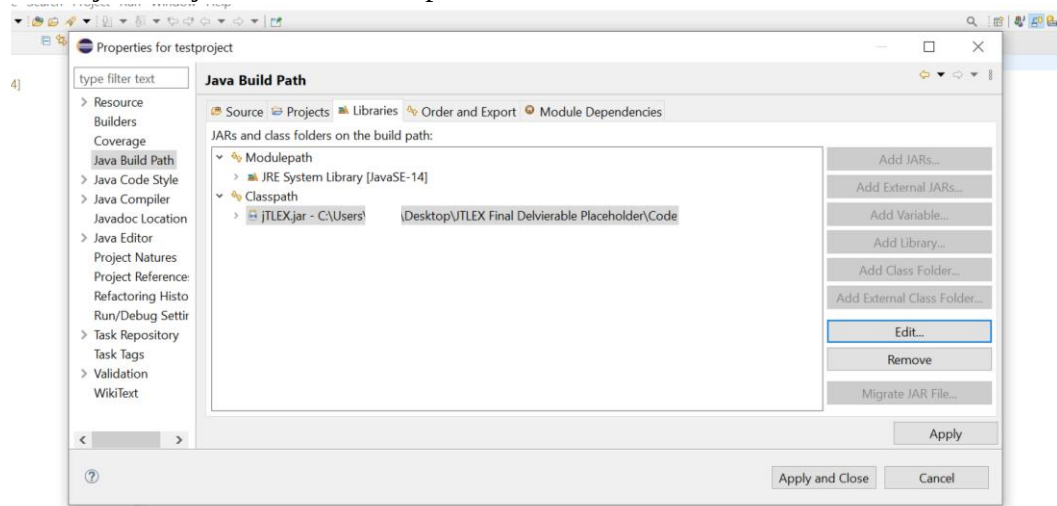
4. Select the Java Build Path tab and open it.



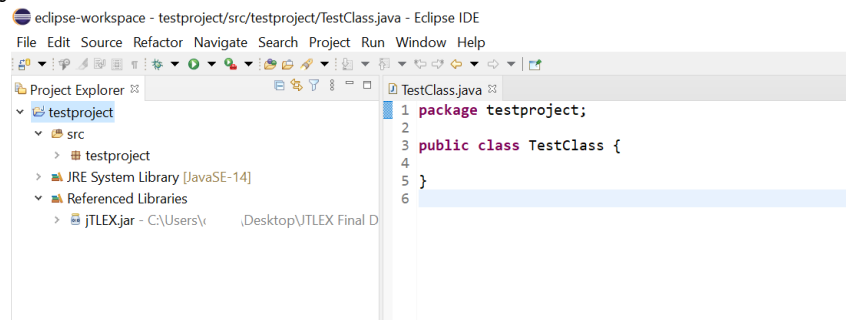
5. In the Libraries tab select class path and click Add External JARs.



6. Select the jTLEX jar file and click open.



7. Click Apply and Close.



Once those steps are completed you can make use of the jTLEX class by simply importing the specific jTLEX class you wish to use in the code you are writing.

i.e. (import edu.fiu.jtlex.data.GraphTCSP;)
