As a User I would like to create an account **so that** I can have the capability of saving notes and receiving notes from other users in the future.

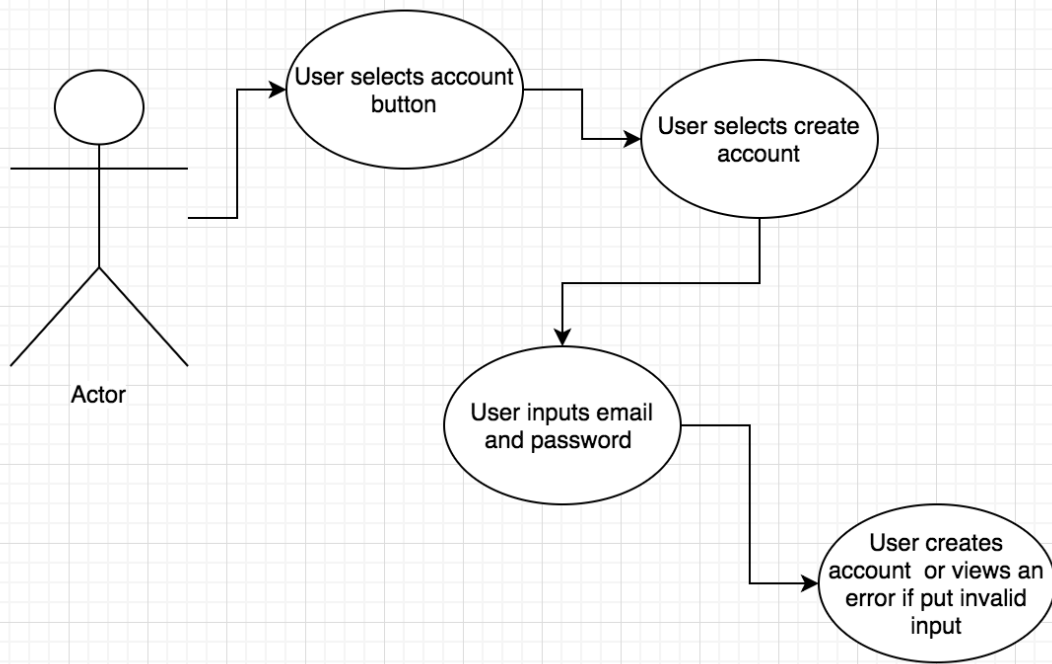
Acceptance Criteria:

- User is automatically signed into account upon creating their account.

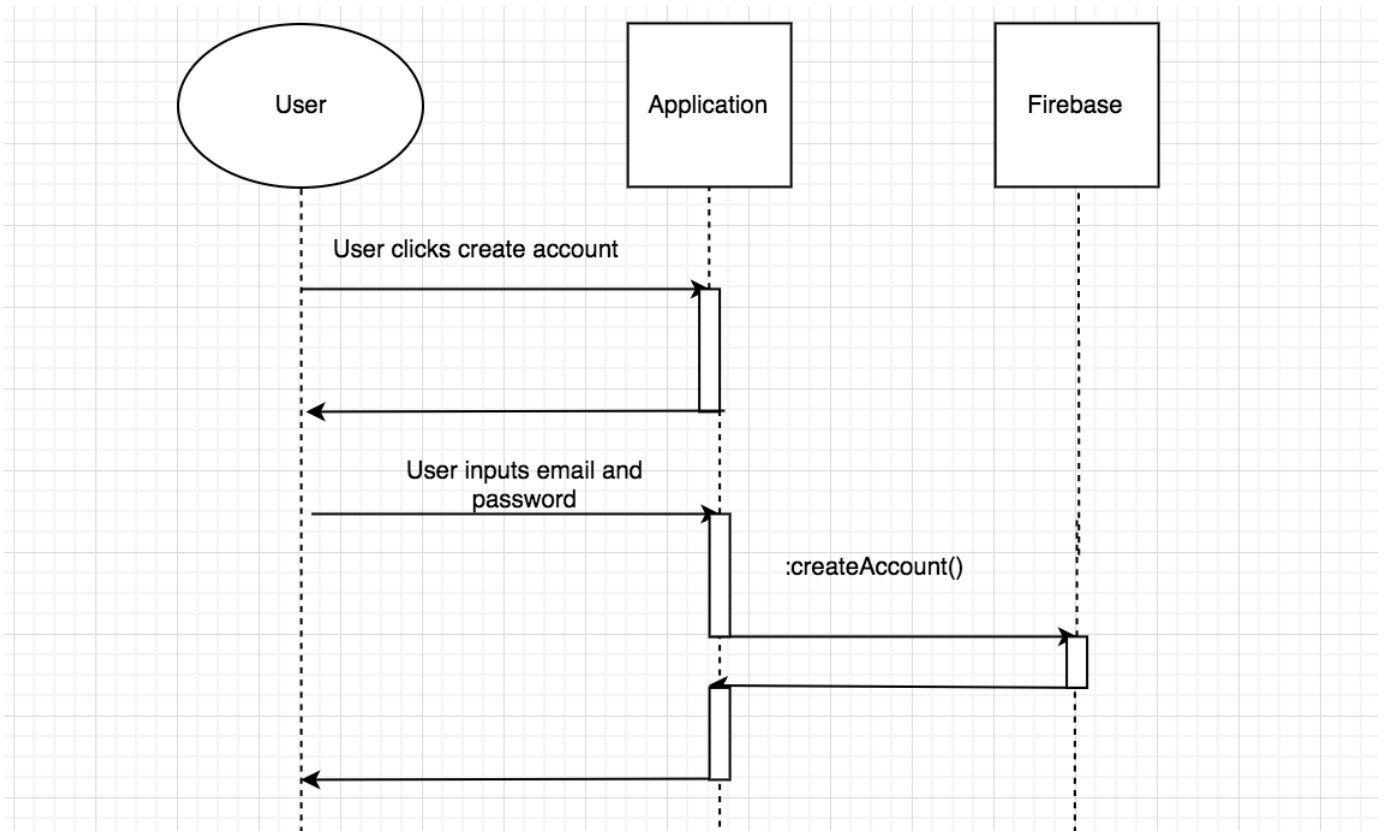
Use Case

 - Account is created or error appears if invalid password/email

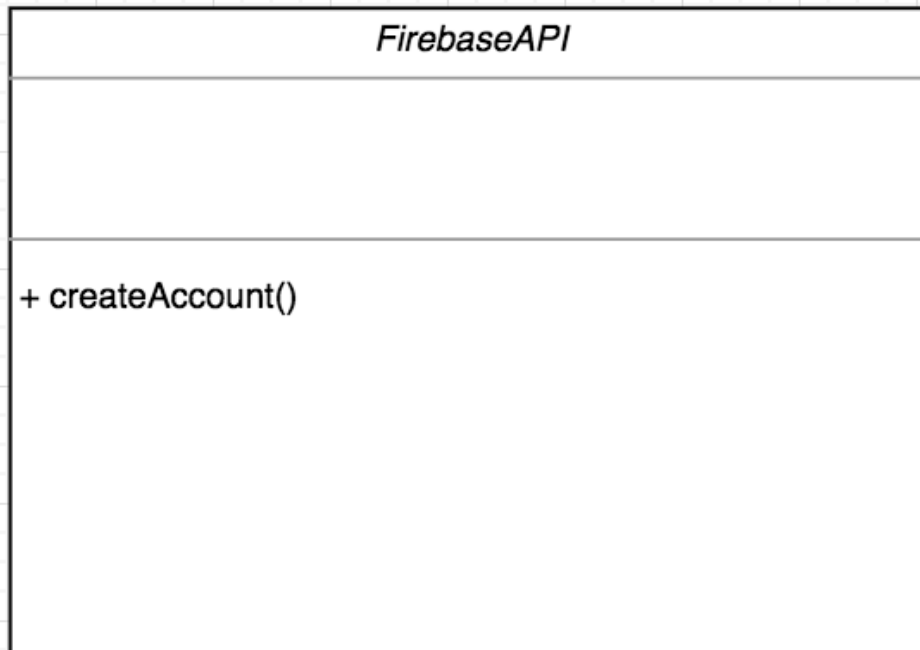
Use Case Diagram
