Firearms Qualification Details: The training will be conducted at the Homestead Training Facility. See attached schedule for specific training dates and times. Annual Tactical Firearms Training will be composed of a combination of live-fire exercises and non-live-fire exercises. The purpose of this training is to introduce and teach officers tactics for real life scenarios.

Facility Amenities:

- Grills and provided propane
- Restroom facilities
- Vending machines
- Snack bar
- Microwave
- Coffee maker (Keurig and Cuban coffee)

Note: Once at the training facility, you will not be able to leave. Please bring your own food, snacks, water and other non-alcoholic drinks.

- Brief Review Use of Force Policy
- Weapon Inspection
- Course Overview

Move & Shoot Instruction and Exercise:

- Officers will be instructed on how to properly shot their firearm accurately while moving. This will be demonstrated with a handgun and rifle.
- Officers will practice how to properly move and shoot in a non-live-fire exercises.
- Officers will perform a live-fire move and shoot exercise.

Shoot-Move-Reload-Shoot Exercise:

- Officers will be instructed on how to properly reload their firearm while not being stagnant. This will be demonstrated with a handgun and rifle.
- Officers will practice how to properly reload their firearm while not being stagnant in a non-live-fire exercises.
- Officers will perform a live-fire move and shoot exercise.

Rendering Self-Aide:

- Officers will be instructed on how to properly apply a Combat Application Tourniquet (C-A-T). The proper application of the Combat Application Tourniquet will be demonstrated.
- Officers will practice applying a Combat Application Tourniquet in a non-live-fire exercise from behind cover and re-engaging a threat after rendering self-aide.
- Officers will perform a live-fire exercise where they will engage a threat, render self-aide from behind cover, and re-engaging a threat after self-aide was rendered.

Rapidly Moving with a Long Gun:

- Officers will be instructed on how to properly move rapidly with a long gun (rifle and shotgun). This exercise will be demonstrated.
- Officers will practice how to properly move and shoot in a non-live-fire exercises.

Moving Through Crowds Exercise:

- Officers will be instructed on how to properly move through crowds with a long gun (rifle and shotgun). This exercise will be demonstrated.
- Officers will practice how to properly move and shoot in a non-live-fire exercises.

Responding to Active Shooter Exercise:

- Exercise will give officers experience in responding to an active shooter after arriving on scene.
- From a starting position of being seated in a marked patrol vehicle, officers will don their rifle plate carriers and ballistic helmets along with removing a patrol rifle from its mounted position in the patrol vehicle. Officers will then engage targets in a live-fire exercise.

Grand Finale:

- Officers will be instructed on the course of fire and a walk-thru will be conducted with the entire group.
- Exercise will encompass all skills previously learned in this training into a final exercise.
