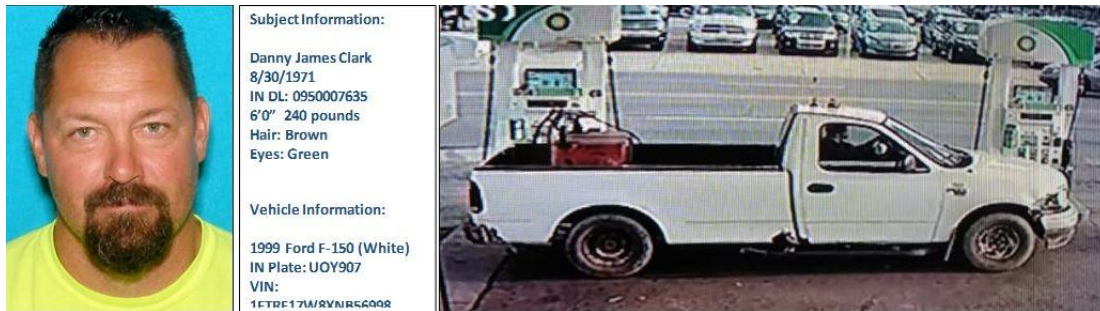

The Southeast Florida Fusion Center received the information below from the Florida Fusion Center regarding traveling wanted person Danny James Clark.

On behalf of the Indiana State Police and the Pulaski County Sheriff's Office (IN), please be on the lookout for Danny James Clark (W/M, 08/30/1971) who is a suspect in an arson/homicide case in Pulaski County, Indiana that took place on 08/13/2018.

Clark has a warrant for domestic violence (strangulation) with nationwide extradition. Clark is believed to be in possession of several firearms and is to be considered armed and dangerous.

Clark was last seen in Kokomo, Indiana in a stolen, white 1999 Ford F-150 bearing Indiana license plate 'UOY907'. At that time, the vehicle had a large, red fuel tank in the bed. The vehicle was stolen out of Carroll County, Indiana and has since been entered in NCIC as stolen. It is believed that Clark could possibly be headed to Florida, where he has fled to in the past.
