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Standardized Field Sobriety Test (SFST) Refresher (24hrs)

CURRICULUM: This 24-hour class is intended to serve as refresher training and to update law enforcement personnel on the changes regarding **"Roadsides"**. This class will bridge the gap in understanding the role of the primary officer stopping a DUI offender and the assistance of a DUI certified investigator completing the investigation. With the use of live participants, students will learn how to observe, identify, and articulate the signs of impairment related to alcohol utilizing SFSTs. This will give the student confidence and credibility in DUI court proceedings. Students will understand their importance in the three DUI investigation phases. The legal aspects of SFST to include, Florida Law, written reports, and verbal testimony will be covered. This training is hands-on utilizing live participants and will give the student the necessary tools to handle DUI detection.
