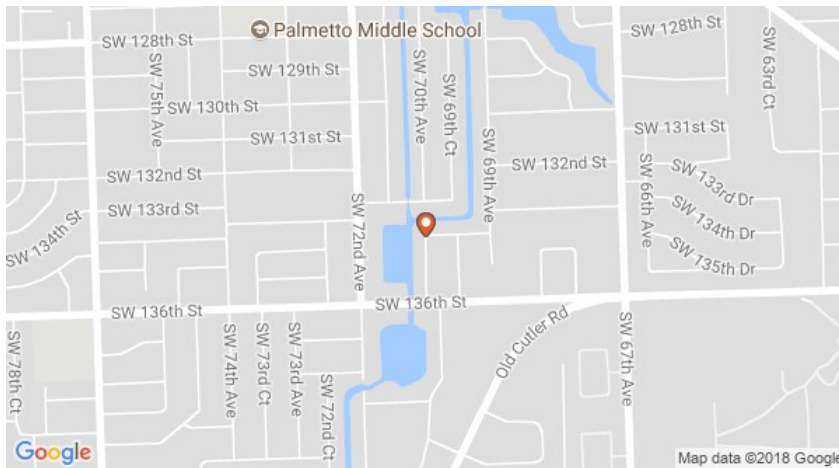

DESCRIPTION - My address is 13400 SW 70 Av, which is on the corner of SW 70 Ave with SW 134 ST. The amount of traffic east bound on SW 134 St. and into the southbound curve on SW 70 Ave between the hours of 4:30 pm to 5:30 pm has increased substantially. Cars routinely swerve automatically into the oncoming lane (northbound lane on SW 70 Ave.) on the curve in order to maintain their speed. The neighborhood would appreciate a police officer to be here during the hours of 4:30 pm to 5:30 pm to observe (and ticket) the violators.

Derrick Bowman:

This traffic concern was assigned to Motor Officer Julian Guerra. The following report was submitted with regard to his findings:

The curved intersection of SW 70 Avenue and SW 134 Street has narrow lanes with concrete curbs on both sides of the road and double yellow lines down the center of the roadway. Vehicles traveling westbound on SW 134 St and turning left onto SW 70 Ave all appear to be going slow and seem to fear hitting the concrete curb so they cross a little into the oncoming lane when no other cars are present or approaching. No excessive speed observed during this detail. Vehicles traveling westbound prior to turning left have great visibility of the approaching vehicles going north on SW 70 Ave. Vehicles traveling northbound prior to turning right have great visibility of approaching vehicles going west on SW 134 St. As cars approach simultaneously from both directions there is adequate space even for two large vehicles. Another observation was when pedestrians are walking the curve. The pedestrian presence forces the vehicle's Driver to straddle towards the center of the road and into the oncoming lane as they negotiate the turn. No problem observed at this time with the roadway as it is design.
