Lend your professional eye to graduating engineers for three hours on Friday, July 31 (1:00–4:00 PM Eastern, fully virtual). No preparation required — we bring everything to your screen.

WHAT JUDGES DO

You evaluate a small set of senior teams — their live presentation, demo, poster, and video — using a simple discipline-specific rubric on the Capstone site. Everything happens in one virtual session; the site guides you round by round.

HOW TO BECOME A JUDGE

- 1 Express interest** at capstone.cs.fiu.edu — Engage section — takes about two minutes (name, affiliation, position).
- 2 Receive your personal registration link** by email and confirm your availability.
- 3 On July 31**, join online; your assigned teams and rubric are waiting in your judge dashboard.

WHAT YOU RECEIVE

- An official **FIU Certificate of Service** documenting your role, issued by the university.
- A front-row look at emerging talent — many judges recruit from the teams they evaluate.
- Membership in a judging community 650+ strong, drawn from Microsoft, Dell, Kaseya, Assurant, Miami-Dade County, and beyond.
