



Your idea. Our engineers. **One semester.**

Propose a project for Fall 2026 and work with a senior team of three to five as their product owner or mentor — guided by professional Scrum and AI-powered engineering.

HOW IT WORKS

You describe a real problem in a short proposal. Student teams review proposals during team formation in the first weeks of the term, and if a team selects yours, you become its **product owner**: you set requirements, meet the team weekly (remotely is fine — scheduling, messaging, and sprint tracking all live on the Capstone site), and watch working software take shape sprint by sprint. Prefer to advise without owning a product? Serve as a **mentor** in your domain of expertise.

WHAT PAST PRODUCT OWNERS SAY WITH THEIR COMMITMENT

"I will meet with the students at least once a week, answer questions and clarify requirements on a daily basis, and provide weekly feedback on the project's progress." — the standard commitment our product owners make, in their own words

HOW TO PROPOSE

- 1 Go to capstone.cs.fiu.edu → Engage** and register as a partner (about two minutes).
- 2 Submit your proposal** — a descriptive title and one strong paragraph are enough to start; documents welcome.
- 3 Submit early** — proposals in hand before team formation get first pick of the strongest teams.

Intellectual-property arrangements, including proprietary and NDA tracks, are fully supported — Prof. Sadjadi works the details with you personally during onboarding.
